However, subsequent to the films release it was felt that the depiction of the characters should more closely resemble the films actors, and therefore this version of the poster was discontinued in favour of Tom Chantrell's artwork. Estimate: £1,500 - £2,500





Heritage Auctions Movie Posters Signature Auction - March 23-24, 2019 Consignment Deadline - January 29

Heritage Auctions' next Movie Posters Signature Auction is scheduled for March 23-24, 2019 in Dallas. While still in its early stages, here are three exceptional movie posters that will be offered at this upcoming auction:

The Bride of Frankenstein (Universal, 1935). Fine/Very Fine on Paper. Insert (14" X 36").

Among one of the most desirable posters in Universal's sprawling horror franchise, Heritage has the greatest pleasure to offer the incredibly rare insert for Whale's wildly successful sequel. Only a scant handful of these posters remain, a shame as it highlights each of the main cast members with a fantastic collage in ghoulish hues, perfect for an equally gruesome picture. This highly desirable insert has benefited from professional restoration. With flaws no longer visible, it once displayed fold wear, some small chips at the edges, and scattered pinholes. Moderate tears in the borders were also addressed, a couple of which extended into the outer background. Much like the rest of the poster's former wear, a slight vertical tear at the center fold into the bottom of the Monster's chin has been rendered virtually undetectable after this skilled conservation. Fine/Very Fine on Paper.

Estimate: \$50,000 - \$100,000.

The Bride of Frankenstein (Universal, 1935). Fine+. Window Card (14" X 22").

A format so rare that it has never before found its way to our auction block, Heritage takes the greatest pleasure in presenting this fantastic window card for one of the greatest horror movies ever made. This incredible window card is a magnificent find for collectors, boasting a fantastic full-color image otherwise only found on the film's style H three sheet. Front and center, of course, is Boris Karloff in his

second incarnation of Mary Shelly's reanimated creation, flanked by leading lady Valerie Hobson and the titular Bride, Elsa Lanchester. In a clever motif, the card frames the characters with a colorful rendering of the Bride's iconic, normally monochromatic coiffure.

The card once had a couple of pinholes, a minor tear at the bottom, and some surface wear in the interior, but these issues have been rendered invisible from professional restoration. Also addressed were a crease and staining in the imprint area and part of the upper image. The borders and imprint area have been airbrushed, and the card has been re-backed on a vintage circa 1935 window card. Altogether, these repairs have created a beautiful finished product perfect for display. Fine+.

Estimate: \$30,000 - \$60,000.

The Wolf Man (Universal, 1941). Folded, Fine/ Very Fine. Insert (14" X 36").

This beautiful insert is considered by most to be the very best format for the film! It is certainly the most rare. The poster has pinholes in the corners and a tear from the right border into the artwork up to the "s" in "Rains." There is a corner bend in the upper left corner and a small tear from the center of the upper border into the Wolf Man's head and in the lower border into the art next to the brewing cauldron. There is some wear to the lower fold. Folded, Fine/Very Fine.

Estimate: \$30,000 - \$60,000.



Casablanca Insert Boosts Heritage Auctions' Movie **Posters Auction Beyond \$1.6 Million**

High demand drives top lot above \$100K

DALLAS, Texas (November 26, 2018) — A Casablanca (Warner Brothers, 1942) *Insert* nearly doubled its pre-auction high estimate when numerous bidders drove its final price to \$102,000, claiming top-lot honors in Heritage Auctions' Movie Posters Auction in Dallas. The total value of the auction, which boasted sell-through rates of 97 percent by value and 96 percent by lot, was \$1,602,103.

The 14-by-36-inch high-demand poster was widely anticipated prior to the Nov. 17-18 auction. Part of the appeal to collectors is the fact that this poster features all of the film's main characters, including the leads played by Humphrey Bogart, Ingrid Bergman and Paul Henreid. The film went on to become one of the most important films in Hollywood history, developing an enormous base of fans and collecting several Oscars along the way, including Best Picture, Best Director and Best Screenplay.

"This is regarded as perhaps the bestlooking of all formats of domestic paper produced for the film, which is among the most popular and important in Hollywood history," Heritage Auctions Movie Posters Director Grey Smith said. "Casablanca belongs in any serious movie poster collection, and this poster can be the centerpiece."



An extremely rare, highly sought-after <u>Thunderball</u> (<u>United Artists</u>, <u>1965</u>) full-bleed British quad more than doubled its low estimate when it sold for \$24,000. Multiple collectors made bids for the poster with artwork by Frank McCarthy and Robert McGinnis. This country-of-origin British paper, in advance quad crown style, captures Sean Connery in his fourth – some say his best – performance as James Bond.

Only a small number of copies remain uncut. This poster was advertised in the British pressbook as the Quad Crown poster, intended to be cut by theater owners into double crown posters (no double crown posters were distributed for the promotion of the film).


A <u>Breakfast at Tiffany's (Paramount, 1961)</u>
<u>Italian 4 - Fogli</u> drew bids from more than a dozen collectors before nearly tripling its low estimate at \$22,800. The 55-by-78-1/2-inch poster, offered for the first time through Heritage Auctions, features a beautiful portrait of Audrey Hepburn by Ercole Brini, who was widely considered one of the best artists in the business.

A <u>Superman Cartoon (Paramount, 1941) Stock One Sheet</u> also drew numerous bids before closing at \$20,400. The 27-by-41-inch poster was created by Paramount with a blank imprint area in which the name of any of 17 individual Superman cartoon shorts could be written or printed.

A dozen collectors made bids on a <u>Creature from the Black Lagoon</u> (<u>Universal International, 1954</u>) <u>Six Sheet</u> with artwork by Reynold Brown until it drew a final price of \$19,200. The horror classic stars Richard Carlson, Julia Adams and Richard Denning as a group of paleontologists who travel to the Amazon and find the famed Black Lagoon and its most

who travel to the Amazon and find the famed Black Lagoon and its most unusual occupant. The film was one of the era's finest and inspired two sequels, and this poster in its large format may be in the best condition of its kind.

Dear Friends, Movie Lovers and Fans of Saul:





This month, we've decided to mix it up a bit by offering several different types of items. This playful postcard of Saul's self-portrait on a laundry bag is one. Read the story behind it **here**.



We're especially excited about some wonderful holiday-themed pieces that have rarely been seen before.

Beginning in the 1950s, Saul would create a unique item celebrating the holiday season to send to friends and associates as a gesture of gratitude. As such, they were printed in very small quantities.






We are offering two different, circa 1960 greeting **cards** along with a large format, single-sided **poster** and a very fun (and functioning!) **flip book** that dates from the 1970s - all using variations of the bird motif, representing forward-looking hopefulness and peace. They're lovely.



We're also offering two publications: the original 1978 printing of the Japanese **IDEA Magazine special issue**, devoted to Saul along with a charming mini book (also Japanese) published in 1986 by **Ginza Graphic Gallery**.



And finally, a couple of film posters. We are debuting the intense international 1 Sheet for Steven Spielberg's **SCHINDLER'S LIST**. This Oscar-winning drama represented one of the last major films that Saul worked on, and although his final design was not ultimately used by the studio, this powerful barbed wire image is well-known and widely admired, especially by Saul fans.





Last but not least, we are offering one example of Saul's rare silkscreen of **THE SHINING**. This particular silkscreen was only printed once, in a very small print run, for Saul's personal use. And, as with all of the items that the Saul Bass Archive will be releasing, the quantity is limited to what Saul had at the time of his death in 1996. We are not reprinting/reproducing anything, and when these items are gone, they're gone.

The Hammer classic premiered in September 1959 and starred Christopher Lee and Peter Cushing, two legends of horror cinema. It is available for £695.

Singin' in the Rain: Movie Review by Brandy Isadora

The 1952 romantic musical comedy, Singin' in the Rain, is one of the few classic films that have remained popular years after its release. The film starred Gene Kelly, Donald O'Connor, and nineteen-year-old Debbie Reynolds. From the moment it hit theaters, Singin' in the Rain, was a huge success and was nominated for several awards and honors. While the musical is very upbeat, making the film required hours of unbelievable physical exertion. Gene Kelly



suffered from a bad fever while filming the titular dance routine. Reynolds, who had no dance experience, suffered bloody feet and the harsh pressure from her costars to keep up. In this case, the sacrifices and hardships were worth it. Singin' in the Rain has withstood the test of time and continues to captivate people's hearts.

While the story isn't about one particular person, the movie describes what happened to many unfortunate actors who couldn't make the transition from silent film to talking pictures. For example, John Gilbert was an extremely successful silent film star. However, when talking pictures started to replace silent films, Gilbert's career was doomed. Gilbert didn't have a bad voice, which was the problem for many of the silent film actors. Yet, his voice was different than what his fans had imagined, and so his career declined. In this particular film, Don Lockwood (Gene Kelly) and Lina Lamont (Jean Hagen) are the two biggest silent screen actors. Since

they look like a gorgeous onscreen couple, fans assume they must be a couple in real life and the studio pressures Lockwood and Lamont to pretend they love each other. Lamont adores Lockwood, but Lockwood cannot stand her. When talking pictures are introduced into the industry, these film stars are in trouble. While Lockwood has a nice voice, Lamont's voice was very high and squeaky and drives everyone around her slightly crazy. The studio panics and scrambles to find a solution.

Every aspect of this film was well done. Jean Hagen is brilliant as the beautiful, but annoying Lamont. In fact, her performance earned her an Oscar nod. Hagen's voice was quite different in real life. Ironically, in the scene where Sheldon is dubbing Lamont's voice, Hagen actually dubs one of the lines herself. Reynolds gives a very convincing performance, but it was not without its struggles. She had no dance experience, which frustrated Gene Kelly. Years later Kelly admitted that he wasn't very kind to Reynolds. Donald O'Connor, who plays Don Lockwood's best friend, Cosmo Brown, is nothing short of brilliant as well. He acts, sings, and dances with such dexterity and precision, that it is no wonder he was able to carve a niche for himself in Hollywood that no one could really rival.

Arthur Freed produced the MGM classic, and Stanley Donen and Gene Kelly directed. Kelly's choreography style was athletic, acrobatic and dynamic. He liked to experiment with different camera angles. The cinematographer was Harold Rosson, who had worked on Treasure Island and The Wizard of Oz.

The physical stamina required to make this film was so great that, after filming the scene "Make 'em Laugh", O'Connor was hospitalized for four days from exhaustion and smoking four packs of cigarettes a day. The day they filmed the musical number and dance sequence for Singin' in the Rain, Kelly suffered from a fever. Reynolds' feet were bleeding after filming the dance sequence for "Good Morning". Few actors could have endured that level of pressure. To this day Singin' in the Rain is regarded as one of the greatest musicals of all time. The movie is funny and brilliant, as it tells the story of early Hollywood and how the difference between silent films and talkies affected the audiences and ultimately the actors.





After his international breakthrough with **THE CONFORMIST**, he had a sensational success with **LAST TANGO IN PARIS** and won an Oscar for **THE LAST EMPORER**. Roeg didn't direct a feature until age 40, having worked his way up the ranks from studio gofer to cinematographer on films such as **PETULIA**. Using his skills as a cameraman along with impressionistic, fractured editing rhythms, he became a master of mood and atmosphere: the decadence of **PERFORMANCE**, the sodden, sensual doom in **DON'T LOOK NOW**, the alienation of David Bowie's **MAN WHO FELL TO EARTH**, a parched, otherworldly Australian Outback in **WALKABOUT**. He engaged all the senses and his best work had a way of getting (and staying) under your skin.



Her beauty and talents made her one of the most famous European actresses in Hollywood and all over Europe between 1964 and 1970 before focused on European productions (some of which she produced herself) - some sexier than others for the pleasures of moviegoers - and enjoy a family life with her long time husband and two children.
