

Among the 250 posters at auction in the upcoming <u>Aste Bolaffi Poster</u> <u>Auction</u> on May 9, 2019, over a hundred lots in the first section consist of posters dedicated to the Cinema. <u>THE AUCTION IS NOW ONLINE</u>!

A careful selection, coming from prestigious private collections, among which important rarities of the Thirties and Forties Cinema stand out.

Among all stand out two splendid posters, <u>Show Boat</u>, the first and rare edition of the 1937 movie with Irene Dunne and illustrated by the extraordinary hand of Anselmo Ballester; and the first edition of <u>Quality</u> <u>Street</u>, the famous 1938 movie with the divine Katherine Hepburn.



Also interesting is the selection dedicated to animated films, with two rare playbills for the Walt Disney <u>The Three Caballeros</u> and <u>Cinderella</u>.



Even the great classics are widely represented with an extraordinary lobby card for <u>Gone with the Wind</u>, the masterpiece with Vivian Leigh and Clark Gable; a second edition of <u>Niagara</u> with Marilyn Monroe; and Clark Gable and Jeanette McDonald in <u>San Francisco</u>.

Rare Darth Vader Costume, Hunchback of Notre Dame Posters To Be Offered

Los Angeles – Bonhams and Turner Classic Movies are pleased to announce that a complete Darth Vader costume from **Star Wars: Episode V** - **The Empire Strikes Back** (estimate: \$1,000,000-2,000,000) will go up for sale on May 14 in the <u>TCM</u> <u>Presents ... Wonders of the Galaxy</u> auction of classic movie memorabilia at Bonhams Los Angeles. The 17-piece costume consists of everything from gloves, boots and a pair of capes to a cod piece and a battery pack. A special public exhibition opens on May the 4th and then from May 10-14.

In 1977, Bryce "Kermit" Eller, tall and with a deep and commanding voice, landed himself a gig making personal appearances as Darth Vader all over the country, from premieres, book signings, conventions, and the 1978 Academy Awards®. He wore the original–and only–Darth Vader costume from Star Wars: Episode IV–A New Hope from the film. By 1979, he was provided with one of a few complete costumes produced for The Empire Strikes Back,




which is the one currently up for auction. Eller continued to make personal appearances as Vader through 1981, at which point he packed the suit up in its two flight cases and stored it in his garage until the present day.

Dr. Catherine Williamson, Director of Entertainment Memorabilia at Bonhams, said: "Darth Vader is one of the most recognizable and infamous characters in the history of film and we are excited to offer this rare costume in our sale. The suit's completeness, remarkable condition, and excellent provenance make it a true rarity in the memorabilia marketplace.

Also on the auction schedule are three lots featuring original movie posters from the 1923 classic <u>The Hunchback of Notre Dame</u>. Interest in these rare items is heightened in light of the recent fire at the Notre Dame Cathedral. The film has been lauded for both Lon Chaney's performance and the built-to-scale replica of the cathedral used during filming.

The lots include a 1923 U.S. one sheet poster (estimate: US\$ 150,000 - 200,000; 1923 U.S. insert (estimate: US\$ 10,000 - 15,000) and a lot including 1923 U.S. title lobby card and scene card (estimate: US\$ 5,000 - 7,000)







Additional highlights from the sale include:

<u>The Phantom of the Opera</u>, Universal Pictures, 1925 with lots including a 1925 Three sheet poster, linen-backed (estimate: \$200,000-300,000); 1925. U.S. half sheet poster (estimate: \$20,000-30,000); and a lot of three 1925 U.S. title lobby cards (estimate: \$5,000-\$7,000).

EMBASSY (1972) starring Richard Roundtree. Sylvester Stallone reprises his role as John Rambo in RAMBO : FIRST BLOOD PART II. Lead singer of The Who Roger Daltrey takes on the role of McVICAR.

Music And Movie Memorabilia Going Under The Hammer At Ewbank's - Auction Taking Place on May 30

The gig took place on December 22 1967, at London's Olympia and featured artists including Jimi Hendrix, The Who, and Pink Floyd. The poster was designed by Barry Fantoni, and is rolled.



Will Smith's 'Men In Black' Suit Going On Sale At Ewbank's - Movie Props on Sale on May 30



Ewbank's, Surrey's leading international auction house, has a raft of <u>movie props</u> going on sale on May 30 with highlight lots including Will Smith's suit from 1997 film **Men In Black**, and chariot driver body armour from **Gladiator**, starring Russell Crowe.


Ewbank's Vintage Posters Auction Will Take Place on May 31

<u>Star Wars</u> (1977) British Quad film poster is just one of the many highlights of the upcoming <u>Ewbank's Vintage Posters Auction</u> which will take place on May 31st. This poster features the artwork of Tim & Greg Hildebrandt, 20th.

This rare version of the UK Quad poster was designed by the Hildebrandt brothers, and was issued when the film was initially released in the UK. However, subsequent to the films release it was felt that the depiction of the characters should more closely resemble the films actors, and therefore this version of the poster was discontinued in favor of Tom Chantrell's artwork.



Other highlights of the auction include British Quads for <u>The Italian Job</u>, 1969 and <u>Waterloo Bridge</u>, 1940; and U.S. One Sheets for <u>To Kill a</u> <u>Mockingbird</u> 1962 and <u>Le Mans</u>, 1971.







THE NEW 2019 SPRING POSTER COLLECTION IS <u>HERE</u>

Dear posterophiles,

In the 1970's the two biggest nonwhite / western / occidental universal icons were Bob Marley and <u>BRUCE LEE</u>.

While the former introduced the Jamaican Musical rhythms (Reggae, dub, ska, toast....) to the world, the second revealed the millennial ancient skills of Asian Martial Arts, creating a cultural phenomenon that in the 70's reached nearly all aspects of the artistic spectrum: Music (Kung-Fu Fighting), Comic Books (Shang-chi the Master of Kung-Fu, Iron Fist), TV (The Kung Fu series with David Carradine) and of course movies with countless martial arts produced movies both in Asia and the US.

While Bruce Lee's movie career was cut short in 1973 as he died (in still mysterious circumstances) at the age of 33, his succinct filmography especially the 4 last movies produced in Hong Kong where he returned in 1970 after failing to make it in Hollywood - despite his role as Kato in The Green Hornet TV series) and being the fighting trainer of Steve McQueen, Sharon Tate, George Lazenby (one of his best friends who was a pallbearers at his burial - cemented his place as the undisputed King of the Martial Arts, thanks to his training by legendary master IP Man.

After the release of his biggest success, <u>Enter The Dragon</u>, which he just completed filming before his death, Bruce Lee's aura and legend reached new heights.

The always cynical and mercantile movie industry needed to capitalize on his death and find a replacement to keep moviegoers filling the seats.

Between 1974 and 1981, literally hundreds of Martial arts movies were produced in Hong Kong, Taiwan and the US using clones of Bruce Lee named Bruce LI or Bruce LE to confuse the audience. This cinematographic genre was dubbed <u>BRUCEPLOITATION</u>.

Bruce Lee's estate was even more cynical when they allowed Robert Clouse to put together archive footage and release <u>Game Of Death</u> in 1978 featuring horribly edited sequences from previous movies except for the now legendary battle between Lee and Kareem Abdul Jabbar.

THIS WEEK'S BLOG (click here) features none of Bruce Lee's movie posters BUT instead 10 of the so-called Bruceploitation movie posters originating from France, Germany, Italy, Japan and the US and sporting incredibly great paintings or images worthy of adorning your walls.

One of those included in the Blog is the magnificent Italian poster for <u>Exit The Dragon</u> <u>Enter the Tiger</u>.



WHAT'S NEW THIS WEEK?

* **NEW ITEMS**: The **2019 SPRING COLLECTION**, strong of 355 posters is available in the <u>NEW PRODUCTS section</u>. Here is a random selection of 20 posters.

Since yesterday was Star Wars Day (May the 4th - May The Force...) here is one of my favorite posters from the <u>STAR WARS</u> saga created by Japanese artist <u>Seito</u> for the original local release in 1978. This one is even rarer as there is a reddish hue to Luke and Leia which is not found on most similar posters.

Another great illustrator is <u>Tom Chantrell</u> who has painted hundreds of British movie posters. One his best creations is the rare 1st edition British Quad poster for <u>The Dirty</u> <u>Dozen</u>.

They are not twelve but just four and revolutionized the musical world with their harmonies and fierce guitar battles. Amazingly beautiful and ultra rare concert poster for <u>Crosby</u>, <u>Stills</u>, <u>Nash and Young</u>'s Salt Lake City show in 1969.

Often named as one of the Top 5 best movies ever filmed, <u>The Godfather Part 1</u> is indeed a must watch. Enjoy the superb design created for the original Japanese release.



Italy should not be only remembered with the Mafia but also and mostly with the magnificent posters it offer us such as the superb painting by <u>Giuliano Nistri</u> for the 1969 Sex documentary, <u>Wages Of Sin</u>. A poster that sells out each time I'm lucky to find a new copy so the countdown is on for this one too...

Another gorgeous woman but this one painted by legendary Pin Up artist <u>Aslan</u> for the 1977 <u>Folies Bergere</u> revue. This is the pink version (we also have others) in perfect rolled condition.

Nicknamed Bebel, <u>Jean-Paul Belmondo</u> is one of the most famous French living icons. Here he is on a rare French poster for <u>La Bande a Bebel</u>, a 1964 documentary about his life and career sporting a great image. <u>Roger Moore</u> and Grace Jones painted by <u>Dan Goozee</u> on the rare commercial Japanese poster for <u>A View To A Kill</u>, the 1985 episode of the James Bond saga.



A brand new limited edition print by Dave Perillo which will remind us all of fantastic memories spent in front of the TV on Sunday mornings watching <u>Looney Tunes</u> cartoons.

<u>Elizabeth Taylor</u> and <u>Paul Newman</u> probably formed one of the most handsome on screen couples in <u>Cat On A Hot Tin Roof</u> as shown on the very rare first edition Italian fotobusta.

Among the many <u>Blaxploitation posters</u> added in the Spring Collection, one of the most striking is the half sheet designee for the 1972 drama, <u>Black Girl</u>.

Like all true geniuses, <u>Prince</u> never saw himself confined by the color of his skin. Enjoy this incredibly rich and glowing limited edition print on foil paper titled **Purple Rain**.



Another genius albeit mastering the Art form of Horror and Crime was <u>Alfred Hitchcock</u>, here on the fantastic Japanese poster designed for the 1973 rerelease of <u>The Birds</u>.

More terror but in full color with a great Italian poster for the 1968 Philipino movie, <u>Brides</u> of Blood.

A fantastic German advertising poster designed in 1973 to promote the <u>Arwa Fascination</u> <u>pantyhose</u> line featuring a half naked model with a python snake. I don't understand the link but the image is truly striking.

Equally blonde but les venomous is <u>Catherine Deneuve</u> here simply diaphanous on the luminous and rare Japanese poster for her 1968 drama, <u>La chamade (Heartbeat)</u>.




French Cinema again with a splendid Italian poster painted by <u>Tino Avelli</u> for the original release of <u>Francois Truffaut</u>'s 1968 romantic drama, <u>Baisers voles (Stolen Kisses)</u>.

Icons are naturally hijacked by brands to enhance a products' appeal and desirability. <u>Levi's Jeans</u> certainly master that Marketing mix with this rare large advertising poster designed for the Japanese market in 1991 featuring a mesmerizing portrait of <u>James Dean</u>.

Japanese design again with a gorgeous image created for the 5th episode of the cult <u>Female Prisoner</u> series.



Our collective hearts haven't stopped weeping for the burning of Notre Dame and the constant defacing of Paris' most beautiful avenues and buildings by the "gilets jaunes" so I wanted to remind all that my native hometown still remains the most beautiful city on earth and is the undisputed City Of Lights with this vintage 1963 French tourism poster, <u>Paris Ville Lumiere</u>.


