



#### ONE SHEET FOR HARRY HOUDINI'S *MASTER MYSTERY CHAPTER 9* HIGHLIGHTS PART I OF EMOVIEPOSTER.COM'S JUNE MAJOR AUCTION



This original vintage theatrical linenbacked Chapter #9 (The Madagascan Madness) One -Sheet Movie Poster for Harry Houdini's first movie serial measures 27x41" and is in very good to fine condition. The poster had tiny paper loss at the top crossfold, with a tiny bit of paper loss 1/2" to the right of that. It had a 1 1/2" diagonal tear just above the top horizontal fold 3" to the right of the top crossfold, solely in the brown background area. The poster had two tiny bits of paper loss in the center of the bottom blank border. It had a few small scuff marks scattered in the left blank border and some tiny tears scattered in the middle of the right blank border, with a few very minor smudges in the other blank borders. Other than the above extremely minor defects, the poster is in really excellent condition, and was in "very good to fine" condition prior to linenbacking. It did not have any restoration, because it didn't need any. At some point after the poster was backed, it was slightly roughly handled, and there are some creases in the excess linen, with one crease in the bottom right corner, slightly touching the bottom right blank corner of the poster.

**The Master Mystery**, the 1919 Harry Grossman & Burton L. King silent mystery magic crime serial ("A super-serial"; "By Arthur B. Reeve and Charles A. Logue"; Houdini is an agent of the Justice Department, sent to investigate a bogus giant company, which is well guarded, especially with the help of a robot, in the movie called "The Automaton", which was the very first robot ever to appear in any movie!) starring <u>Harry Houdini</u>, Marguerite Marsh, <u>Ruth Stonehouse</u>, Edna Britton, and William Pike. Note that this serial movie was Houdini's first appearance in a movie, and the producers knew what his fans wanted, and almost every chapter ended with Houdini captured, and the next one began with him making an amazing escape. Note that 13 of the 15 chapters of this movie presently survive. A restoration was made of the remaining 13 chapters, and title cards and images were used to fill in the missing plot of the two lost chapters, and that reconstruction of this movie is available to be viewed! The great magician <u>Harry</u> <u>Houdini</u> only appeared in this movie and four others, and none of those were serials. Movie paper of any kind from any of those five movies is incredibly rare!

This movie was Harry Houdini's very first movie, and it was his only serial, and it had "The Automaton", the very first robot in a movie. So it is certainly a very historic movie. Posters from it were unknown until around 35 years ago, when the son of the man who produced the movie surfaced, and he had one one-sheet from each of the fifteen chapters! Those were quickly sold, and over the years, a very few of them have returned to auction (we have auctioned four different chapters, and we were later reconsigned two of them, so we have auctioned six posters, but two of them were reruns of previous sales, and each was the only example of that poster we had ever auctioned). In 2013, we auctioned a one-sheet from "The Grim Game", another Houdini movie, but not a serial, and that poster auctioned for \$67,166, a world record for a Houdini poster (either movie poster or magic poster)! Now, we are auctioning a chapter that we have never auctioned before, and this one shows Houdini pointing a gun at the Automaton, in a room filled with human skulls! And the fact that this is 2019 is also significant! That is because this is no longer a "collectible movie poster", but it is now an "antique movie poster", because just about everybody defines an "antique" as being a century old, and this poster now is a full 100 years old!

During this year's Cinevent Classic Film Convention, convention chair Michael Haynes and Dealers' Room coordinator Samantha Glasser announced that the Cinevent name will be retiring at the end of the 2020 show and Michael will be stepping aside at that time.

Samantha is founding a new organization which will be presenting a classic film convention in Columbus, Ohio beginning in 2021 on Memorial Day weekend. Michael and Samantha will co-present the 2020 convention with their respective organizations and Michael will be consulting on the founding of the new organization and its 2021 show.

More details will be coming later this year. While the name Cinevent is retiring next year, the tradition of celebrating classic film on Memorial Day weekend in Columbus will continue!"

### **What Price Hollywood**

#### **Through June 15 - The Museum of Modern Art**

Beyond the nostalgia that colors how we think about classical Hollywood films, there is also what critic Parker Tyler once described as its "monstrous and pernicious" influence on society and culture. And since relations between female and male characters figure heavily in virtually all of the studio system's feature films and promotional materials, now more than ever it's worth looking closely at the different ways gender roles and behavior were portrayed.

What Price Hollywood presents a wide range of movie posters, from the silent era through the 1960s, that epitomize the Hollywood marketing machine's deployment (and occasional subversion) of masculine and feminine stereotypes. The exhibition highlights ways in which these graphic and photographic representations shaped—and continue to shape—the moviegoing public's understanding of romance and sexuality; how the studios' formulaic use of body language between male and female performers defined "standard" couplings; and how certain genres allowed subversive female agency and queer perspectives to sneak into poster art.

Along with the poster exhibition, a <u>film series</u> reveals how Hollywood manipulated erotic imagery onscreen, and how subtle, empowering performances by Barbara Stanwyck, Louise Brooks, Marlon Brando, and Gloria Grahame simultaneously upheld gender norms and hinted at alternative models of sexual identity.

Warner Brothers Original U.S. Half Sheet Poster Style B (22x28), folded, for the Michael Curtiz adventure masterpiece THE SEA HAWK (1940) starring Errol Flynn, Brenda Marshall, Claude Rains, Donald Crisp, Lester Matthews, Flora Robson, Alan Hale, Gilbert Roland and Henry Daniell. Errol Flynn plays a buccaneer who is enlisted by Queen Elizabeth to harass the Spanish on the high seas. He does just that and in the process falls in love with a beautiful woman on board one of the Spanish ships. He's taken prisoner by the Spaniards, but, of course, escapes with a powerful message for England. In the middle of all this is some fancy fencing, some swashing of the proverbial buckle, a great score by Erich Wolfgang Korngold and some great costuming and art direction. This movie is beloved as one of the great buccaneer movies and a top Flynn role. This poster, the style B half sheet, is undoubtedly one of the best posters worldwide on the film and also one of the rarest. This poster has never been seen at auction, and the art is completely different from any other U.S. poster. This half sheet is one of the textured-finish posters that are characteristic of Warners' card-stock posters of this period. The poster was folded at one time, but has clearly been stored unfolded for years.



Here are 20 beauties chosen randomly among the more than 13,000 posters the Gallery offers

The loss of one of Paris' main sources of beauty is still difficult to fathom. Let's reminisce the beauty of what once was with this vintage French tourism poster from 1963 showing the now gone "flèche" de <u>Notre-Dame de Paris</u>.

Another French icon - thankfully still standing - just recently honored for his incredible career at the last Cannes Film Festival is <u>Alain Delon</u>, probably the most handsome man who ever lived. Proof with this incredibly rare and cool teaser poster for the Japanese release of <u>Un Flic</u>.

Jane Fonda acted next to Alain Delon but it is another French man she fell in love with and married, <u>Roger Vadim</u>. He directed her in <u>Barbarella</u>, the 1968 erotic Sci-Fi Cult movie represented here with its original US half sheet movie poster adorned with the legendary painting by the greatest living illustrator, <u>Robert McGinnis</u>.



Among the many <u>limited edition prints</u> offered in the Gallery, one of the most impressive is the 2018 regular version for <u>The Mummy</u>, revisited by Stan and Vince for Mondo.

More horrific beauty with what is considered to be one of the best ever **Dracula** movie posters, painted by **Renato Casaro** for the Italian release of Dracula 1972 A.D starring **Christopher Lee**.

Bloody red colors used by <u>Gunther Kieser</u> to enhance the striking appeal of the 1960 German concert poster for <u>Ella Fitzgerald</u>, the undisputed Queen of Jazz.



The visual iconography (tattoos, swords and guns) of the Japanese Yakuza, claiming themselves to be the direct heirs to the Samurai, is one of my favorite. Hence the very large number of <u>Samurai-Yakuza</u> posters in the Gallery (the largest such collection outside of Japan). Here's one in a rare circle-sized format starring <u>Bunta Sugawara</u> in the third episode of the <u>Kanto Street Peddlers Clan</u> series.

Advertising posters have the very difficult task to make us both dream and want to acquire a given product. Here's one who manages to do that job: the large vintage 1969 Swiss poster for the **Delial** tanning lotion brand.

We stay in the "cosmetic department" but we add a stylistic with one of the most iconic US one sheet posters from the **BLAXPLOITATION** movement created for the original release of **Black Shampoo** in 1976.



More fabulous Afro with the stunning very limited edition print of <u>Jimi Hendrix</u> titled Rainbow (one of 4 different versions we have). The digital image doesn't do justice as the poster is printed on foil holographic paper with incredible shine and reflections.

Among the close to 300 <u>James Bond</u> posters in the Gallery, here is the vintage and very rare complete set of 10 Italian posters for the original release of the 1967 spoof <u>Casino</u> <u>Royale</u>. This is one of the many <u>fotobusta and fotobusta sets</u> we offer (the largest selection outside of Italy).
