Timeless Classics Among Films Featured in Heritage Auctions' Vintage Posters Auction


Title lobby card for The Golem *makes just second auction appearance*

DALLAS, Texas (July 15, 2019) — A rare title lobby card from the first true sound horror film that had long-lasting significance in the Universal Horror series is expected to be among the top draws in Heritage Auctions' <u>Movie</u> <u>Posters Auction</u> July 27-28 in Dallas, Texas.

"This auction includes very rare paper, some of which comes from some of the most popular films of all time, like *Dracula*, *Casablanca* and *Gone with the Wind*," Heritage Auctions Vintage Posters Director Grey Smith said. "This is an auction with appealing options for many collectors, because of the diversity of the lots offered."

<u>Dracula (Universal, 1931)</u> <u>Title Lobby</u>

Card (estimate: \$40,000-80,000) captures a dramatic image from Bram Stoker's gothic thriller that is the definitive vampire film. Despite the financial challenges faced during the <u>Depression</u>, Carl Laemmle, Jr., bought the rights to the novel and the Broadway play in which Bela Lugosi was the star. Lugosi assumed the same role in the film version, solidifying his legacy as

the ultimate Count Dracula. A potential centerpiece for any <u>collection</u>, this beautiful lobby card rarely is offered at auction.

Gone with the Wind (MGM, 1939) three

<u>sheet</u> (estimate: \$20,000-40,000) is a stunning rarity, one of only two copies known to remain in existence, from the film that earned a trove of Oscars that included awards for Best Picture, Best Actress, Best Director, Best Screenplay and Supporting Actress. Arguably the best image created out of all five styles of the three sheets offered by <u>MGM</u>, it is among the rarest and in highest demand among classic collectors. This auction will be the first in which Heritage Auctions has offered this gem from the Theaters of Old Detroit Collection.


The Golem (Paramount, 1920) CGC Graded

Title Lobby Card (estimate: \$20,000-40,000) spotlights another monumental horror film that is considered a landmark of early German Impressionism. This lobby card is extremely rare, and in exceptional condition. Showing the Golem (clay monster) created by a rabbi to save Prague from the Emperor's order of

expulsion, the card is one of a very small number known to exist and just the second title card from the film offered at auction.

A Foolish Wives (Universal, 1922) One Sheet (estimate: \$20,000-40,000) shines a light on a film that was one of Universal's most successful at the time of its release, but one that was made at a staggering cost of more than \$1 million. The only known copy of this stone lithograph, featuring star and director Erich von Stroheim, was sold originally in 1995 and is being offered by Heritage Auctions for the first time.

An insert for <u>The Hunchback of Notre Dame (Universal, 1923)</u> (estimate: \$15,000-30,000) is one of only three copies known to exist and is offered by Heritage Auctions for the first time. The insert shows the role that made Lon Chaney a star: Victor Hugo's hunchback, Quasimodo. The film, which helped set the standard for later horror films, was one of the top grossing silent films of all time, and helped to bring Universal Studios into the spotlight.

A one sheet for <u>The 39 Steps (Gaumont-Fox, 1935)</u> (estimate: \$10,000-20,000) highlights one of director Alfred Hitchcock's first major international successes, and features many of the stylistic and thematic elements that later became integral parts of his later work.

Two lots from one of the most popular movies ever made are featured in the sale. <u>Casablanca (Warner Brothers, 1942) Window Card</u> and <u>Casablanca (Warner Brothers, 1944) Australian One Sheet</u>, each with a pre -auction estimate of \$10,000-20,000, were made for the classic on which shooting started before the script was complete. Paper for this film, which won three Academy Awards, including Best Picture and Best Director, is extremely scarce and in high demand among collectors.



Movie Poster Auction August 23, 2019

Ewbank's will be presenting its <u>Movie Poster Auction</u> on August 23rd at 12:00 p.m. The auction will feature some great posters including Star Wars Marler Haley and Hildebrandt to name a few. Here are some samples:

Star Wars (1977) British Quad film poster, rare poster with artwork by Tim & Greg Hildebrandt, 20th Century Fox, rolled, 30 x 40 inches. This rare version of the UK Quad poster was designed by the Hildebrandt brothers, and was issued when the film was initially released in the UK. However, subsequent to the films release it was felt that the depiction of the characters should more closely resemble the films actors, and therefore this version of the poster was discontinued in favour of Tom Chantrell's artwork.



<u>Star Wars</u> (1977) British Quad film poster, Pre Academy Awards, Style C, directed by George Lucas, artwork by Tom Chantrell, folded, 30 x 40 inches

<u>Star Wars Return of The Jedi</u> (1983) An early teaser British Quad film poster when it was named 'Revenge of The Jedi', rolled, 30 x 40 inches



Advertising posters from Airline companies are numerous yet they are most impressive when seen in series produced with all the various destinations flown around the world.

As far as graphics and visuals are concerned, Pan Am topped the field with some of the most incredibly sexy visuals created especially between the mid 50's till the mid 80's

On July 13, the **Royal Ontario Museum** (ROM) unveils the Canadian-exclusive presentation of *It's Alive! Classic Horror and Sci-Fi Art from the Kirk Hammett Collection, with presenting sponsor Cosmo Music*. This otherworldly and imaginative exhibition features a trove of rare artwork and collectible objects amassed over decades by consummate collector Kirk Hammett, lead guitarist of Metallica. Exploring the interplay of creativity, emotion and popular culture, the exhibition includes more than 100 pieces from 20th-century cinema ranging from *The Cabinet of Dr. Caligari* (1921) to *Alien*(1979) *It's Alive! Classic Horror and Sci-Fi Art from the Kirk Hammett Collection* is organized by the Peabody Essex Museum, Salem, Massachusetts, and is on view July 13, 2019 through January 5, 2020.

"Horror and sci-fi are among the most versatile, dynamic and enduring genres of cinema," says Josh Basseches, ROM Director & CEO. "Acting as a mirror for societal fears, these films and the accompanying artwork reflect the collective cultural anxieties of the time. This evocative exhibition deepens our understanding of the evolution of cinema art and its relationship to culture."

<u>It's Alive! Classic Horror and Sci-Fi Art from the Kirk Hammett Art</u>

Collection features rare cinema posters from the 1920s to 1980including the only surviving copy of the original 1931 Frankenstein poster-as well as one-of-a-kind electric guitars from Kirk Hammett's personal collection and authentic movie costumes with life-size mannequins. The exhibition traces how, decade by decade, horror and sci-fi cinema responded to a number of broad cultural events and developments. Each section of the exhibition uses poster art to convey underlying anxieties of particular eras, including the fear of mortality around the Great Depression of the1930s; scientific progress in the mid-20th century; the fear of invasion and espionage post-1945; and the rise of feminism in the 1960s.



"Like the films they promote, these pieces are important metaphors for the issues of the times in which they were created," says Arlene Gehmacher, ROM Curator of Canadian Paintings, Prints & Drawings. "Some of the posters are riveting. They can provoke, excite, and enthrall, reflecting but also shaping the visible and psychological fears of an individual, community, or nation."

"Like the films they promote, these pieces are important metaphors for the issues of the times in which they were created," says Arlene Gehmacher, ROM Curator of Canadian Paintings, Prints & Drawings. "Some of the posters are riveting. They can provoke, excite, and enthrall, reflecting but also shaping the visible and psychological fears of an individual, community, or nation."

Kirk Hammett has dedicated the last three decades to creating one of the world's most important cinema-art collections and credits it as a primary source of inspiration for his own musical creativity.

"I got into the business of collecting horror, which is really not a business at all, a long time ago. I think it's become my midnight calling or maybe my lifetime obsession. I guess some would say obsession, some may say occupation and others would say it's just plain insanity," says Kirk Hammett. "It is very exciting for me to have Toronto be the second stop on our quest to bring my collection to everyone who is genuinely interested in these horror movie posters, props, and memorabilia. Canada is a great country, Toronto is an amazing city, and I'm honored to be able to start crossing borders with my collection at the Royal Ontario Museum."

"We'd be lying if we said that we didn't scream in excitement when this opportunity was presented to us. Working with the ROM has been nothing short of incredible, and we're so excited for *It's Alive* to open in July. What a perfect exhibition to align with our brand," says Vanessa Azzoli, Marketing Manager, Cosmo Music.

The ROM will host a special ROM Speaks event on July 23 with Kirk Hammett and Dan Finamore, the Russell W. Knight Curator of Maritime Art and History at the Peabody Essex Museum. Tickets will go on sale beginning May 21 and range in price from \$15 to \$20.




