Our "First Ever Major Mondo Print Auction" completed with \$732,660.00 in sales, see all the results for this great auction here!



eMoviePoster.com's <u>"First Ever Major Mondo Print Auction"</u> (consisting of 2,346 Mondo prints from the collection of Alamo co-founder Tim League) was SUPPOSED to end 12/13. But 7,900 new bidders registered, and they ALL tried to log in exactly as the auctions started closing on the 13th, crashing the site.

eMoviePoster.com quickly paused all the auctions, and then extended every one by 24 hours, so that they all ended 12/14. The auctions were also expanded to 4 hours (from two), which reduced the load on the site, and many other steps were taken as well, and all 2,346 auctions ended without a problem on the 14th.

Many, many prints sold for record prices, and the overall auction took in \$732,660 in sales. All the money raised goes to help the Alamo Drafthouse chain pay their employees during this most difficult time (especially hard for movie theaters, of course).

A Personal Look Back at 2020

With *LAMP*, we had just finished a fantastic batch of auctions in December, new auctions were lining up well, we had gotten our new Production Code Database online (a culmination of 10 years working with production codes) and smoothed out the few kinks AND just finished topping the 65,000 code mark.



With *Hollywood On The Bayou* (our local company) we had set up a travelling exhibit called **Backdrop Louisiana** from our personal collection, which was to travel around the state modifying the exhibit to highlight films made in specific parishes and we were working to get the new Louisiana Film Channel off the ground.



With *Movie Poster Archive* (our non-profit) we topped the 500,000 pieces donated mark and opened an outlet in the French Quarter.

And with our home life, all the family was healthy and running around. After we closed our first *Hollywood On The Bayou* exhibit in Slidell, we went on a family vacation to Universal theme park in Florida and everything was going so well that we even bought an annual pass!!!!



That month, Sue and I both came down with a mysterious virus about a week apart. Each of us were sick for 5 days of high fever, nausea, headaches, achy and no energy. Sue went to the doctor and he said that was definitely a respiratory virus but none they had on file.


Then the pandemic hit, everything became a blur, and the world exploded!

Movie Poster Archive – the outlet in the French Quarter closed with the pandemic but MPA still received approximately 250,000 pieces donated for the year.

Personal – we're all still healthy and slowly back to running around, trying to see when we can go back to Universal. (though we seem to twitch a lot more now)

We hope everyone has a LOT better 2021!!

Silent Classics Make Some Noise During Heritage Auctions' Most Successful Vintage Posters Event Yet

Charlie Chaplin and Rudolph Valentino join Bogart and Bergman, King Kong and Marx Bros. in realizing nearly \$4 million at auction

DALLAS, Texas (Nov. 25, 2020) — Here's looking at you, Rick and Ilsa.

Over two days in late November, Heritage Auctions held its most successful Vintage Posters event ever — in terms of both quality and prices realized. Look no further than <u>the Casablanca six-sheet</u> <u>that sold Saturday for \$384,000</u>, an enormous, gorgeous poster so seldom seen in public only once before had it passed through the Dallas-based auction house's doors.

"A shining example of a classic poster for a classic film," says Grey Smith, Heritage Auctions' Director of Vintage Posters. In other words: *Worth every penny.*

Yet that six-sheet was only one of seven posters to sell Saturday in the six figures, helping push the final tally for <u>the Nov. 21-22 Vintage Posters</u> <u>event</u> past the \$3.9 million mark, with almost 1,800 bidders participating in the auction. No previous poster sale at Heritage had ever before cracked \$3 million.

And not far behind Bogart and Bergman was *King Kong*: <u>A three-sheet for</u> <u>the 1933 beauty-and-the-beast tale sold Saturday for \$336,000</u>. "A pleasant surprise," says Smith, whose high estimate for the poster pre-auction was \$250,000. And *Kong* wasn't alone in surpassing expectations.

The only known copy of a one-sheet for the 1938 reissue of *Dracula*, discovered in 2003, realized \$312,000 – more than four times its estimate. A three-sheet for 1921's silent-movie masterpiece *The Kid*, Charlie Chaplin's feature-length debut as director and star, sold for \$228,000 — more than two times its high estimate of \$100,000. <u>A Son of</u> *Frankenstein* half-sheet realized \$180,000 – three times its high estimate.

And, perhaps most remarkable, <u>a one-sheet for 1926's *The Son of the Sheik* went to the highest bidder at \$120,000</u>. That, too, was several times over estimate, a recurring theme throughout the event that spanned the history of cinema, from silent films to *Star Wars* and far beyond.

Says Smith, "I've been after that *Son of the Sheik* poster for 40 years. There are only a few out there. This one arrived clean, nice. I wasn't terribly surprised it sold that high. I valued it reasonably, but thought it was the best Rudolph Valentino poster."

Its sale price, along with that for *The Kid*, is perhaps most notable because Smith has been told countless times over the last 40 years that silent-era posters won't sell, that there isn't much of a market for advertisements for movies modern-day audiences didn't see in theaters. The November event proved otherwise, especially when a poster is as rare as <u>the three-sheet for the Marx Brothers'</u> <u>1933 chef-d'oeuvre *Duck Soup*, a one-of-a-kind that sold Saturday for \$114,000</u> (again, nearly twice its high estimate).

"This has been going on for 40 years or more," Smith says. "People would say, 'Well, they're pretty, but nobody is going to care.' They said the same thing about the early post-sound material, too. People said buyers would only want posters from science fiction movies from the 1950s or more contemporary films, because they saw those on TV. I don't think anything could be further from the truth."

Indeed, 19 of the 20 top lots in the auction were for films made in 1942 or earlier. The most modern offering in the Top 20 was for 1982's *Creepshow*: <u>Artist Joann Daley's original artwork for the horror anthology realized \$50,400</u>.

"When it comes to posters, there's the historical factor, of course," Smith says. "The silent era only lasted 20 to 25 years, and that paper has to be scarce because when sound came in, all of the poster exchanges went in and took those posters and trashed them because they thought they would never go out again. That's why it's rare. *The Son of the Sheik* is beautiful, too, because it's stone lithograph. It knocks your eyes out."

The same could be said of most every offering among the 860 posters sold in the Nov. 21-22 event.

"Classic titles, great images and rarity is just the perfect combination," Smith says. "And the auction proved just that."

James Bond 007 - 'A Time To Buy' Auction Highlights & Results

Ewbank's recent James Bond 007 "A Time to Buy" auction was a tremendous success, with many items far surpassing their auction estimate. Here are a few highlights:

The 1962 <u>Dr. No British Quad</u> featuring Mitchell Hooks artwork hammed at £22,000, exceeding its pre-auction estimate of £6,000 -£9,000.



<u>A second example</u> is also with an estimate of £5,000 - £8000 sold for £13,000.



The Style C British Quad for the movie You Only Live Twice featuring Sean Connery in the bath tub auctioned at \pounds 3,500, beating its pre-auction estimate of £1,000 - £1,500.

A door panel for the film <u>On Her Majesty's Secret Service</u> reached a hammer price of £9,500, shattering its estimate of £1,000 - £1,500.

Here is just one of those, the <u>1979 Air France poster</u> which I particularly love for its mysterious hue around the Empire State Building bridging my two countries, France and the US.







Art by 'Gentleman' Gene Colan.



Speaking of out of this earth heroes who chose New York / Metropolis as their home base, <u>Superman</u> naturally comes to mind. Set of 2 commercial posters printed on foil paper (hence the reflections you see in the pictures).



Sadly too often, we neglect true heroes for charlatans who will make us believe we need to elect them...Stunning portrait of <u>Burt Lancaster</u> by <u>Jean</u> <u>Mascii</u> for the French Grande poster of the preacher drama, <u>Elmer Gantry</u>.

We need heroes who will both fight and think. A rarity among Men like <u>Muhammad Ali</u> was...The Greatest. Half sheet poster for the 1977 biopic with Art by <u>Robert Tanenbaum</u>.

Colors, joy and loud music....A much needed cocktail presented here on this very rare vintage concert poster for the band <u>Mountain</u>'s show at the Boston Tea Party in 1970.







More Kaleidsocopic psychedelia with the aptly titled <u>Kaleidoscope</u> poster by David Nordham printed in 1971 by the famed headshop company, <u>Pandora</u>.

After those images, I'm sure your eyes are swirling and aroused so this poster for <u>Aroused</u>, the 1966 sexploitation film, seems appropriate.

Let's leave New York for a short instant to transport us to a place without buildings, snow, covid and far far away... Vintage 1967 tourism



poster advertising travels to <u>La Nouvelle Caledonie (New Caledonia)</u>, the French southern hemisphere paradise.

You don't have to travel to the far end of the world to admire exotic beauties. Italy seems a great place to settle with some of the most beautiful women such as <u>Elsa Martinelli</u>, looking even more gorgeous on the rare italian fotobusta poster for <u>The Tenth Victim (La decima vittima)</u>, one of the greatest films from the 60's.



Sweden is also a place I'd recommend if you are in a hunt for goddesses, but they are more of the tougher side such as <u>Christina Lindberg</u> in the cult 1973 sex revenge murder movie, <u>Thriller A Cruel Picture</u>. The large 2 panel Italian poster is ultra rare especially in this near mint condition.

Back to New York with music and colors with this wow limited edition print created recently by <u>David Byrd</u>, the original Fillmore East Artist, to commemorate <u>Sly And The Family Stone</u>'s 1968 shows at the legendary venue.

New York's musical legend wouldn't be what it is without the Madison Square Garden, 'the world's most famous arena' which in 1971 hosted the first ever charity concert which was recorded, filmed as <u>The Concert for</u> <u>Bangladesh</u>. The Swedish movie poster is another exclusivity from the Gallery.



I know that France allowed ski resort stations to be open but banned lifts (another "directive" which will stand among the hundreds of stupid ones edicted by our officials all around the world)!!! I have no idea whether Switzerland also banned ski lifts but James Bond certainly would go around that ban and dazzled on skis as George Lazbenby did in <u>On Her Majesty's Secret</u> <u>Service</u> where the movie was partially filmed. Rare Japanese poster with Art by both <u>Robert</u> <u>McGinnis</u> (Lazenby and Rigg) and <u>Frank</u> <u>McCarthy</u> (Savalas, skiers and explosions).

As snow falls, Skiing is de rigueur even without Olympics Games this season. Very rare original poster for the <u>1964 Innsbruck</u> <u>Winter Olympics</u>.



Surfing the clouds and space is also an




