<u>Ewbank's The Surrey Auction House</u> will present their W. E. Berry Original Poster Artwork Unreserved Auction on February 28, 2020 at 12:00 p.m.

W. E. Berry Ltd. originally opened at 13 Currer Street, Bradford by William Berry in 1888 in Bradford. In the early 1900s, his son, William Edward Berry took over and after a split from his father's business partner, he changed the name of the company.

W.E. was introduced to Fred Martin of Paramount and the pair started a business relationship that cemented W. E, Berry's position as one of the leading producers and distributors of film posters. Berry's printed most and distributed all of Paramount's posters, but Berry's also produced posters in the early period for the railway companies and for Bertram Mills Circus.

This auction has some incredible items up for grabs, including these Bertrum Mills posters. There are lots of vintage circus posters in the auction, which are attracting a great deal of interest.

Original RKO U.S. Three-Sheet Poster for the Richard Fleischer directed film noir THE NARROW MARGIN (1952) starring Marie Windsor, Charles McGraw, and Jacqueline White. The film also features Don Beddoe, Harry Harvey, Gordon Gebert, Donald Dillaway and Franklyn Farnum. One of the gritty film noirs for which RKO became respected. It all takes place on a train. A police detective plays a deadly game of cat and mouse to protect the widow of a slain gangster about to testify in a trial. A group of mobsters on the same train is out to kill her. This is the simple premise upon which one of the truly tense movies of the noir canon is built. The three sheet we offer here is quite rare in this format. One sheet poster have been offered regularly, but not this oversized poster. Three sheet posters are large-format posters which are printed on two separate panels. These panels are joined together to present as one poster. This poster was clearly used in a theater and it is worn. Color is good, but there is some fold separation in one area. Chapter 1 one sheets were usually uncluttered with the inset photos that are found on posters for subsequent chapters. Ralph Byrd played the fearless detective. He's out to get a villain called simply "The Spider". We are introduced to this nefarious character in the first chapter, "The Spider Strikes." You can rest assured, as millions of moviegoers did in 1937, that this Spider-Guy is no match for Tracy. The serial also stared Kay Hughes, Smiley Burnette, Carleton Young, Francis X. Bushman, John Dilson, Harrison Greene, Buddy Roosevelt and Roy Barcroft. This poster in in very fine condition. Colors are



vivid. The poster is mounted on an older linen, and is in no need, in our opinion, of rebacking. For serial collectors, this is one of the best posters! MovieArt Austin guarantees that this poster is an authentic U.S. one-sheet poster for this film.








Romance and elegance summed up perfectly on the Japanese poster (this one for the video release) of Wong Kar-Wai's masterpiece, In The Mood For Love.
