# Son of Frankenstein Italian Poster Could Fetch \$120K at Heritage Auctions

Casablanca, Horse Feathers, Walking Dead, Jaws also represented at March 27-28 event

The only known copy of a 4–Fogli from Boris Karloff's third and final appearance in his signature role could be one of the top offerings in Heritage Auctions' Movie Posters

Auction March 27-28.

Son of Frankenstein (E.N.I.C., 1940) Italian 4 – Fogli with Francesco Giammari Artwork (estimate: \$60,000-120,000) was housed at one time in a private Świss collection. This largeformat poster (measuring 55-1/4 by 77 -1/2 inches), featuring a spectacular design from the classic film, is offered through Heritage Auctions for the first time. A potential centerpiece of any horror collection, it captures Frankenstein's Monster emerging from a shadow. Considered the final truly great Frankenstein movie at Universal, it features a stellar cast that included Bela Lugosi, Basil Rathbone and Lionel Atwill, in addition to Karloff. included a stellar cast that included Basil Rathbone and Lionel Atwill, in addition to Karloff.

"This sale features an array of beautiful Italian posters, including this magnificent Son of Frankenstein poster," Heritage Auctions Vintage Posters Director Grey Smith said. "Posters from any of the Frankenstein movies are always in demand, and Francesco Giammari's artwork on this one is extraordinary, making this a potential centerpiece for any collection of posters from the horror genre."



A Casablanca (Warner Bros., 1942) Half Sheet Style B (estimate: \$30,000-60,000) comes from the iconic war drama that is among the most popular films ever made, and the Style B half sheet is among the film's most popular posters, widely accepted as the more desirable of the two half sheet styles produced for the film. The focus is on the portraits of Humphrey Bogart and Ingrid Bergman in their most beloved roles, and includes images of five of their co-stars: Paul Henreid, Claude Rains, Conrad Veidt, Peter Lorre and Hollywood newcomer Sydney

An extremely rare *The Walking Dead* (Warner Bros., 1936) Italian 4 - Fogli with Luigi Martinati Artwork (estimate: \$30,000-60,000) is one of just two known copies, presented in stone litho, of a spectacular design from one of the most in-demand Italian movie poster artists, offered for the first time ever at Heritage Auctions. Because of the similarities, including a lack of dialog for Karloff's character, between this role and the one he played in Frankenstein, he demanded that more lines be written in to differentiate the two.


Fans and collectors of classic comedy posters will be drawn immediately to an exceedingly rare Horse Feathers (Paramount, 1932) Three Sheet (estimate: \$25,000-50,000). This extraordinary stone litho three sheet captures the Marx Brothers in one of their funniest Paramount films, in which Groucho is the new president of Huxley College, which has not won a football game in more than 40 years. Nearly a century old, this rare three sheet retains bright color and will make an exceptional addition to any collection.



A wonderful copy of the *Monsieur Beaucaire* (Paramount, 1924) One Sheet (estimate: \$25,000-50,000) is being offered at Heritage Auctions for the first time. This gorgeous stone litho image captures Valentino, one of the premier stars of the 1920s in a film in which his wife, Natacha Rambova, controlled production values. The offered poster is the only known copy of this one sheet for the adaptation of Booth Tarkington's 1900 short novel and 1904 stage play of the same name.

A <u>Jaws</u> (Universal, 1975) Seven Sheet with Roger Kastel Artwork (estimate: \$15,000-30,000) is massive in scale (83-1/2 by 92-1/2 inches), creating a format almost never printed for any title; to date, Heritage has offered just one other seven sheet: a very rare <u>Bonnie and Clyde poster that sold in 2011</u>. One of just a handful of copies known to remain in existence, this rare seven sheet has never been offered before by Heritage Auctions. Kastel's image for the film, created for Steven Spielberg's classic, is universally recognized as one of the most recognizable in films, especially when presented in such impressive scale.



Dracula by Basil Gogos (2002) Signed Original Acrylic Artwork on Canvas (estimate: \$10,000-20,000) is a one -of-a-kind image of Bela Lugosi as Count Dracula. Offered for the first time at Heritage Auctions, it comes from the artist who gained his fame largely by illustrating magazine covers for *Famous Monsters of* Filmland, including Frankenstein's Monster, the Phantom of the Opera, the Mummy, the Wolf Man, the Gill Man, King Kong and Bram Stoker's infamous count. Included with the stunning portrait of Lugosi are several signed letters from Gogos with their original mailing envelopes, photocopied concept sketches for the painting, signed prints of the painting, and a restrike photo from *Dracula* that Gogos used as a reference. The painting itself is flawless and shows absolutely no signs of wear or use, a dream piece for any horror collector.



Another large-format gem in the auction is *Spirit of* Youth (Grand National, 1938) Six Sheet (estimate: \$6,000-12,000), the first poster Heritage Auctions has offered from former heavyweight champion Joe Louis's first film role. It is the only copy known to remain in existence from the film made less than a year into his reign as heavyweight champ.

# Dracula laughs all the way to the (blood) bank at Ewbank's £80,000+ Vintage Movie Poster auction.

Bidding bonanza sees 98% of lots change hands as estimates are trounced

Fangs certainly ARE what they used to be as the star lots proved at **Ewbank's** £64,000 Vintage Poster Auction on February 26.

Vampire films starring Christopher Lee inspired some of the most vividly graphic and kitsch poster designs in British cinema history. As an investment, these are now paying back more per square inch than many other works on paper.

This time round three examples in particular showed just how melodrama and colour can combine to pull in the bidders.

Leading the way was **Dracula Prince of Darkness**, a 30 x 40 inch British Quad poster, for the 1966 Hammer classic. With the ghoulish Lee underlit as the Count peering menacingly out of the poster, next to the block title letters dripping with red, this was all schlock fans could wish for and it left the £700-1000 estimate behind to sell for £2,375.



At £1,750, the 30 x 40 inch British Quad poster for Lee's 1958 debut as the Count, in the simply titled **Dracula**, is a more straightforward design and so, perhaps not as inspired. Nonetheless, as the beginning of the Hammer franchise, it holds much cachet and is a rarity in such good condition and it more than doubled the top end of its £500-800 guide.

**Taste the Blood of Dracula**, from 1969, brought the Hammer poster design to almost an apogee of self-parody, revelling in the strapline Drink a pint of Blood A day, no doubt a cheeky reference to the Milk Marketing Board's Drinka pinta milka day slogan from its long-running campaign. Another  $30 \times 40$  in British Quad, and showing Lee in full-fanged mania amid dripping red, a blonde victim looking on in horror, it shunned a £300-500 estimate to soar to £1,375





As expected, a 30 x 40 inch British Quad poster for the classic British gangster film noir *Get Carter*, from 1971, starring Michael Caine, fetched the top price at £4750.

A US One Sheet film poster for the 1971 movie **Le Mans** (1971), starring Steve McQueen had the added attraction of having been obtained from a press reception at the London Hilton, Park Lane following a press preview of the film in the capital. Pitched at £250-350, it made £1,375.



As usual, rarities from the Star Wars franchise did well, led by a price of £1,875 for a US advance teaser poster billed under the title **Star Wars: Revenge of the Jedi** (1982) against hopes of £400-600.








**Bullitt** (2014), a Zoetrope Galleries limited edition art print, initialled by the artist Henry Villegas & numbered 113/300, also excited film fans. The 24 x 36 inch artwork came with a certificate of authenticity to sell for £1,875 against a guide of £200-400.

The James Bond franchise also continues to draw a large following. Despite the continued delay of its release, No Time To Die is already making serious money from its associated artwork in the form of promotional posters.

Six British 30 x 40 inch Quad posters for the postponed November 2020 release, each showing a different character including Daniel Craig and Rami Malek, abandoned a £200 -400 estimate to go for £1,250

A Main April One Sheet teaser poster for the planned April 2020 release, showing an image of Daniel Craig, measured 27 x 40 inches and was estimated at £80-120. It sold for £625.





"There really was something for everyone in this sale," said specialist Ewbank's Alastair McCrea. "The enduring popularity of the movie poster as a collectible was underscored here by both the fact that 98% of the lots sold, and the money they attracted was around 55% higher than the highest estimate for the entire sale."

Dear Posterophiles,

Illustration Art is at the core of the Gallery's DNA.

Obviously within its name but also as the Main source of the Art we offer from all around the world.

My love for the Art of Illustration dates back to old turn of the 20th Century books either drawn by THE greatest illustrator, Gustave Dore, or some of the pages of Mucha's *Le pater* that I was exposed to as a young kid by my beloved dad.

The realism of the drawings, the incredible detailed pages still resonate to this day and made me eternally in love with the simple yet powerful illustrative Art, above all other Art forms which I admire too.

This kind of Art has been vanishing due to most movie producers, book publishers and other advertisers preferring digital or photography visuals - to painted illustrative Art - to enhance their commercial products.


So in my endless search for great illustrative Art, I came across a stunning very limited edition print of *Dr. No* done in 2018 by a true gentleman and Artist extraordinaire called PAUL MANN.

Mann is experienced with 40 year + of illustration Art, from Advertising to book covers and now being the most in-demand illustration Artist having published tens of very limited edition prints with an output, mixing both retro style and Modernity, that is not only large in quantity yet never fails in quality.

Having bought several original Art pieces by Mr Mann for my own personal collection, I'm always very proud to display his oeuvre in many of the Blogs when I can grab some of the prints which sell out in seconds (literally) when initially offered.

<a href="Style">Style</a> (Questi fantasmi).

Horror and beauty brought to another level with one of my Top 10 Japanese movie posters ever designed, i.e. the one printed for <u>The Fearless Vampire Killers</u>, the 1967 horror comedy starring real life couple, <u>Roman Polanski</u> and <u>Sharon Tate</u>.

Feminine beauty comes in all colors and the more colors, the better. Sumptuous limited edition print commemorating Alice Coltrane's groundbreaking 1971 Jazz album, *Journey In Satchidananda*. We also have the Variant version.

Another colorful Alice, as trippy as the singer above, is Lewis Carroll's creation, Alice In Wonderland, adapted by Walt Disney in one of the most 'out there' cartoons ever displayed on the big screen. The poster for the 1972 Japanese rerelease is another rarity that hardly comes by.

Beyond Disney, the most popular Animation films come from Japan with the Anime genre. Many of those movies were adapted straight from Mangas such as Akira, the most famous of them all, created by Katsuhiro Otomo and released in 1988 on the big screen. The Thai movie poster is as unique as it is rare.









Sexier than Anime (and less obscene than the *Hentai*) are Max Flesicher's classic 1930's cartoons of the lovely <u>Betty Boop</u>. Here are a trio of limited edition prints (sold individually) by <u>John Keaveney</u>.

Le clan des siciliens (The Sicilian Clan) is among the best loved French movie posters (and among the best heist movies ever filmed) thanks to the 3 titans (Gabin, Delon and Ventura) starring in it. The Polish poster designed by Marian Stachurki is also the rarest to find. Another Gallery's exclusive!



<u>Anita Ekberg</u> is another buxom Blonde beauty who never failed to raise the naturally already elevated temperature of hot blooded males. Very rare original half sheet poster for <u>La Dolce Vita</u>.

Even Hell goddesses can cry....Superb Art by 'Big' John Buscema used as a Day-Glo greeting card for the 1971 Marvel Third Eye series of blacklight cards and posters.





Go Nagai's creations (Mazinger, Great mazinger and UFO Robot / Goldorak) are among the most well known of the Anime genre all around the world thanks to the success of the TV series particularly in France and Italy where many episodes were also released in theaters. 
