


Entertainment, Memorabilia And Movie Props Sale August 12, 2021

Highlights include an autographed suit signed by all four members of Queen

A white paper suit, signed by all four members of iconic rock band Queen, worn by an extra in the legendary video for their 1984 hit, Radio Gaga, is set to be sold at auction with a pre-sale guide price of between £2,500 and £3,500.

The suit will be one of more than 250 lots in Ewbank's Entertainment, Memorabilia and Movie Props sale, which is taking place on August 12 starting at 9:30 a.m. in the UK.

It has been consigned for sale by lan Phillipson, who was invited to be in the video as he was a member of the Official Queen International Fan



Club. The suit comprises a long-sleeved pullover, trousers and balaclava. The torso of the top was signed by all four members of the band, Freddie Mercury, Brian May, John Deacon and Roger Taylor, at the video shoot at Shepperton Studios, in London on November 24, 1983.



With the Tokyo Olympics on the near horizon, a collection of items from the 1968 games in Mexico is sure to intrigue sports fans. The items originally belonged to British sprinter and finalist in the 4 x 400metre relay Martin Winbolt-Lewis, and have been valued between £800 and £1,200.


The lot consists of the official team BOAC airline bag, 'Aztec Gold' Adidas spikes, running vest, number, competition badge, rain jacket, Olympic pennant, team issue towel, photo of the British 4 x 400m Relay team and a handwritten note by Martin Winbolt-Lewis. It was purchased at a charity

Among the many items of film memorabilia on sale is a pair of prop plaster caryatids from the 1997 blockbuster Titanic. Caryatids are sculptures of a female figure which are used as an architectural support, taking the place of a pillar or column.

The pair was on the wall of the first-class dining saloon in the film and is the only pair in existence. The figurines also appear in the James Cameron book on Titanic, and each stand 54cm tall. The pair has a guide price of

between £400 and £600.

From the ever-popular Harry Potter film franchise, is a selection of original prop production-made labels for Weasley Wizarding Wheezes, as seen in Fred and George Weasley's shop, which has been valued at between £150 and £250. Fred came up with the idea for the Basic Blaze Box, which contained an assortment of magical fireworks such as whizz-bangs and whammy rockets. They are of various sizes and some have sticky backs for use in filming.



Other lots of note include a blue and gold Joseph Ribkoff top for Barbara Windsor playing Peggy in Eastenders. It is a size twelve and comes with an EastEnders certificate of authenticity and a postcard autographed by Windsor. It has been valued between £400 and £600.



A two-page handwritten letter from legendary American jazz trumpeter Louis Armstrong has a guide price of between £200 and £400. It is on headed paper, dated August 1 1932 and was sent to the jazz band that the vendor's father led in the 1930s.

A signed copy of The Monty Pythons Autobiography, bearing autographs from John Cleese, Eric Idle, Michael Palin and Terry Jones, to the title page, has been valued between £150 and £250.


HERITAGE AUCTION'S MOVIE POSTERS AUCTION - JULY 24-25 RESULTS

Casablanca Czech poster shatters pre-auction estimate


The first Post-War Release *Casablanca* Czech poster shattered its pre-auction estimate of \$40,000 - \$80,000 when it sold for \$168,000.00 (including BP) at Heritage Auctions' <u>Movie Posters Auction</u> held on July 24-25.


Only offered at Heritage once before, this poster was released most likely around 1946 before the Communist takeover of Czechoslovakia, as this was the first year of the MPEA (Motion Picture Export Association) whose seal is seen in the upper right. The MPEA was set up after the war ended to help spread the release of American-made movies in occupied and foreign territories.

Other auction highlights include *It Happened One Night One* Sheet Style A, which hammered at \$102,000 and the *Dracula* (Spanish-Language Version) Argentinean One Sheet which sold for \$78,000 surpassing it's estimate of \$30,000 - \$60,000.

EWBANK'S AUCTIONS JULY 23RD VINTAGE POSTERS AUCTION RESULTS

Ewbank's Auctions' July 23rd Vintage Posters was a huge success, with 157 of the 162 lots sold, and the auction totaling over double the pre-auction estimate. The top lot of the day was this *Forbidden Planet* quad at £12,000 inc premium.



The 30 x 40 inch British Quad film poster features the first release of the iconic "Robby the Robot" artwork and had been consigned from a private collection. Ewbank's specialist Alastair McCrea knew it would do well and had given it an estimate of £3,000 -5,000, but fans largely bidding online competed fiercely and the price soared.

"It was indicative of the whole sale," said McCrea. "Where posters for horror and sci-fi films from the 1940s to '70s have lively and colourful designs, great retro titles and a strong element of kitsch, they tend to do very well indeed."

Other auction highlights include:

British Quad double bill for Hammer Productions *Rasputin-The Mad Monk/The Reptile* 1966 was estimated at £700-1,000, but with two great designs and excellent condition, it went for a premium-inclusive £2,250.

Pre-auction estimate of £500-800 for the 1965 British Quad for *Dr. Terror's House of Horrors* was surpassed by the final price of £2,750.00.





Classic titles also performed well.

The UK Quad for *How to Marry a Millionaire*, 1953, hammered with premium for £2,250, exceeding its estimate of £500-800.

The Star Wars UK quad poster, Pre Academy Awards Style C hammered at £3,800.

Art is all about perspective and great perspective enhances Art. This poster from the late 1960's campaign for <u>SAS Airlines</u> is giving us an incredible visual perspective of Manhattan's 6th Avenue midtown buildings. One of my all time favorite travel posters (and only the second time in 10 years I'm offering one!). The poster is already linen backed.

Perspective again and a poster which certainly wouldn't pass the "woke / Me Too / politically correct" test these days yet manage to praise ALL forms of beauty including the feminine one proving that curves and design go hand in hand. Admire this very rare poster for Ferrari titled *Decisions Decisions* printed in 1982.

Perspective is also needed when it comes to History with too many having short memories. Black Power was not just an American movement but was also prevalent in many other countries. This very rare poster for the 1975 Mexican action movie, <u>El poder negro (Black Power)</u> is obviously now extremly sought after due to its visual and title. 





Along with Jazz, the Blues is one of African American's greatest additions to modern culture. Muddy Waters is one of his greatest preachers and this 1972 German concert poster is among the rarest and the most beautiful designed by Gunther Kieser. A Gallery exclusive. Back to New York with one of my all time favorite <u>Blaxploitation</u> posters, i.e. the half sheet poster for Hell Up In Harlem with its iconic Art by Robert Tanenbaum.

Harlem Nocturne was one of his best tunes so it's appropriate to follow up with THE greatest Jazz bandleader, Duke Ellington, soulful and contemplative on the cover of the magnificent 1963 British Tour program.

The power of Red again with one of the tens of brand new and ultra rare Bill Graham-Fillmore series posters added and one of my favorites...The superb poster (BG 200) for the 1969 San Francisco series of shows played at the Winterland by Crosby Stills Nash & Young. Design by Randy Tuten.







When I said RARE posters earlier I really meant it. One of Japan movie posters' Holy Grail is the original poster for Barbarella, here in magnificent condition. No other words needed.

While the above movie and poster depicts and promotes eroticism in space, let's bring us back on this earthly plane yet still observing laws of gravity! *Cheeky* poster designed by Ferrari for the Italian release of the 1973 German erotic movie. Overnight Models.




