Our September 27 Alternative Movie Posters Showcase sale features a plethora of highly attractive prints from a fascinating, quickly growing category. Establishing itself as a market a little over a decade and a half ago, these types of posters are a distinctive and attractive breed of promotional media, often created by independent artists and fans.

While official movie posters tend to prioritize star power and mainstream appeal, alternative versions strive to encapsulate the spirit and thematic depth of the film. Whether it's a clever piece of minimalist art or a detailed illustration, these posters use unique design elements to highlight underappreciated aspects and reinterpret the movies.

Although not typically commissioned for large-scale promotional activities, these works have found a niche in the art market and are cherished by collectors for their originality and innovative approach. They are also valued because of their limited print runs, which often sell out within minutes or hours of being offered by the artist.

A Reel Rarity: The World's First Movie Poster Premieres in Heritage's Event Packed with Cinema

The Lumière brothers'1895 beauty joins spectacular finds from the realms of horror, sci-fi, pre-Code Hollywood and more on Sept. 30

DALLAS, Texas (Sept. 5, 2023) — Often the Most Wanted Thing in the collecting world is the first of its kind: The first edition of Chaucer's *The Canterbury Tales*, Mickey Mantle's rookie card, a leather log book from the first moon landing, Issue #1 of the *Superman* comic book.

Ever-popular as collectibles, vintage original movie posters have been a bit cursed with the problem that its first is so elusive. The first real public narrative movie screening took place in Paris in 1895 — it featured the Lumière brothers' comedy short *L'Arroseur Arrosé (The Waterer Watered)* — and true to this golden age of *Belle Époque* illustration and advertising art, the event was promoted by a massive, drop-dead gorgeous poster that featured an enthusiastic audience enjoying this particular movie and this startling new kind of entertainment.

The prolific ad artist Marcellin Auzolle was its creator. As noted by the Los Angeles County Museum of Art (LACMA): "Auzolle's poster depicts an audience watching the comedy *L'Arroseur Arrosé* and evokes the lively energy associated with the first public screening of Lumière films on December 28, 1895, at the Grand Café in Paris. The program featured ten short films, projected at a scale of around 6½×9 feet. The audience appears just as animated as the filmed performers, gesturing, laughing, and enjoying the collective experience."

In a first of firsts, on September 30, Heritage Auctions will be the first auction house to offer <u>this first movie poster to the public</u>, as it leads a sweeping <u>Movie Posters</u> <u>Signature ® Auction</u> packed with other remarkable pieces of cinema history.

There were actually two posters designed for the Lumière event: The other design, by Henri Brispot, features a crowd of people waiting to enter the screening, and that poster sold at Sotheby's in 2018 for six figures. That one has its charms, but for his design the canny Auzolle instead chose to depict the thrill of the movie*watching* experience — men and women, boys and girls (and a happy theater attendant) laughing heartily at a screen flickering with the image of a wayward kid playing a simple prank on a gardener (who happened to be played by the Lumières' actual gardener François Clerc).

Auguste and Louis Lumière were of course cinema pioneers: This was the first time film was used to portray a fictional story, and the first comedy — the 49-second short is model slapstick. This original Auzolle poster, 128 years old and more than five feet wide, is in remarkable condition. Its colors are rich, autumnal and gemlike, its lines are clean, its smartly-dressed audience figures are alive with raucous appreciation for what's unfolding in front of them in contrasting black and white. This is, in other words, the first movie poster to show the film it's promoting. It comes to Heritage via one Dominique Besson of Paris.

"This poster is one of the first I bought over 40 years ago and is therefore from my personal collection," says Besson. "It was folded in the archives of a person whose grandfather had worked with the Lumière brothers. As you could see, it had remained folded since the origin, nearly 130 years."

Prior to this moment in motion-picture history, any promotional material for an event to show off the new film technology depicted the technology rather than any individual film, or ads for the non-narrative titles were often simply text. Our very definition of what makes a movie a real movie, and a real poster a real movie poster, is here in this remarkably preserved Lumière -Auzolle moment — this uniquely beautiful artifact of the modern movie-going experience.

"We are privileged to handle such an important piece of cultural history," says Zach Pogemiller, Heritage's Associate Director of Movie Posters. "This poster represents the birth of an entirely new genre of public art, one that continues to captivate and inspire the public worldwide. The *Cinématographe Lumière* French grande marks both the birth of the movie industry and poster collecting."



This first movie poster is merely one exceptional offering in a Heritage event teeming with rarities. So much of the material from cinema's earliest days are lost to time, so when beautiful examples of primary industry art surface, collectors pay attention. Such is the case with this lobby card from Fritz Lang's 1927 masterpiece Metropolis. It is the only known example of this card. The scene image, depicting Maria's robot double leading a crowd of underworld workers in revolt, is original and unmarred. The first US release material on this title is so rare

that a complete lobby card set for *Metropolis* has yet to surface in the collecting community. If your goal is to build a set, you need this card.

In fact, theatrical promotional materials in the early horror and science fiction genres continue to dominate the collector market. This <u>ultra-rare jumbo lobby card</u> for 1931's *Dracula*, directed by Todd Browning and starring Bela Lugosi, has been offered only once before in a long-ago auction, and it casts a spell over audiences with its depiction of darkness and desire. From another Lugosi classic: <u>This Son of</u> *Frankenstein* half sheet marks only the second time Heritage has offered this style from Lugosi's last monster appearance in 1939; and <u>this truly remarkable complete</u> <u>press book</u> for *The Bride of Frankenstein* is a heart-stopping find. The cover glows with images of Boris Karloff, Valerie Hobson and Elsa Lanchester; the back cover is filled with examples of the near-vanished large format posters that were available upon release. The internal pages cover everything from advance and current publicity articles to the full range of lobby displays and additional posters that include the impressive six-sheet format. A genre collector's Holy Grail.

Jumping back across the pond to the former Soviet Union: Once upon a time, following the Russian Revolution, acclaimed Constructivist artists also worked as graphic designers for the state. This vintage 1925 poster for the movie Death Ray was designed by the great Alexander Rodchenko. The movie, directed by Lev Kuleshov, a pioneer of montage theory, is set against the backdrop of post -revolutionary Russia and unfolds in a dystopian universe where technological prowess and totalitarian ambitions converge. The poster design reflects this impulse in the dramatic and familiar abstraction ascendant at the time. This outstanding country-of-origin poster is a first-time offer --- the only example Heritage has seen and in exceptional condition.

In this event Heritage also offers a bounty of vintage creations from the world of James Bond releases, including from 007's debut in *Dr.*



No via <u>this striking British quad</u> with artwork by Mitchell Hooks and David Chasman, replete with the very special agent and all his ladies, and long considered superior to its American counterpart. An <u>acetate lightbox one sheet</u> for *Thunderball* marks Sean Connery's fourth turn as Bond, and was meant to be displayed with a backlight source. It beautifully illuminates Frank McCarthy and Robert McGinnis' iconic artwork depicting 007 in his adventures fighting S.P.E.C.T.R.E.



This is merely a fraction of the treasures on offer in this signature event: A <u>vibrant</u>, <u>unrestored one sheet</u> promoting the pre-Code Barbara Stanwyck movie *The Miracle Woman*, directed by Frank Capra, is the only known surviving example. A <u>My Man</u> <u>Godfrey one sheet</u>, in the extremely rare style D, is thought by some to be the superior design for its more realistic and elegant portraiture of the starring couple William Powell and Carole Lombard, and is one of just three known in the world. And continuing the lobby-card love in this auction, on offer are such rarities as two

different singles from Todd Browning's ever-controversial 1932 classic *Freaks*; an <u>ultra</u> -rare, <u>unrestored lobby card</u> for 1933's *The Invisible Man*; and complete lobby card sets for 1938's *The Adventures of Robin Hood* (this set in beautiful condition with a <u>linen finish</u>) and a <u>mint set</u> for *Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs* illustrated by the great Disney favorite Gustaf Tenggren. Dear Posterophiles,

I randomly bounced on some old <u>Columbo</u> episodes on Prime TV which brought me back to my golden years when I was a teen in Paris, religiously watching every episode on French TV, which I will always credit to making me discover Johnny Cash who guested in one episode - while hopelessly waiting to see whether Mrs Columbo would ever appear!

<u>Peter Falk</u> became world famous between 1971 and 1978 as a slouched, weird looking (right eye closed), heavy accent talking, dirty trench coat wearing, chain smoking police lieutenant/inspector that we all loved.

Beyond this iconic role, we should not forget the 1927 New York City native had also been Oscar nominated for Best Supporting Actor TWICE in 1961 and 1962 which he bitterly lost.

Despite having lost his right eye at 3 years old due to cancer, Falk strived to achieve everything he put his bright mind to. After getting a Business Master, he became a Certified Public Accountant and even enrolled in the Merchants Marine, Falk decided to switch to acting early on and landed many supporting roles along with the greatest actors along with many appearances in TV shows.

He briefly put his career on pause to enroll in a league of American volunteers to fight along Israeli soldiers during the Six Day War but never saw any combat since the war ended before he could even be dispatched overseas!!! His longtime friendship with John Cassavetes, Gena Rowlands and Ben Gazzara gave him many great dramatic roles between 1969 and 1977 including classics like *Husbands*.

The big breakthrough came in 1970 when he landed the role of Lieutenant Columbo which he heavily pitched producers - after first choice actor Bing Crosby passed due to a Golf tournament commitment!!!

A meticulous actor, Falk exhausted his fellow actors on the episodes' set as he rehearsed and shot as many takes as needed to achieve the perfect mix of comedy and grit that the role demanded. The worldwide success made the series last 8 seasons till 1978.

By then, the fact that he spent most of his time on set took a toll on his first marriage ending in a very costly divorce.

After Columbo ended, Falk was very much in demand and acted in several comedies between 1978 and 1981 when he took an acting pause before enjoying resurgence from 1987 till 2007 after his appearances in Wim Wenders's Wings Of Desire and The Princess Bride.

Struck with dementia in 2007, Peter Falk passed away in 2011 after having appeared in no less than 179 movies or TV shows including the 43 Columbo episodes.

THIS WEEK'S BLOG (click here) presents several of his movies and TV shows posters including ALL the rare Italian posters from the Columbo show (probably the in the Top 5 steady sale from the Gallery since its opening - having sold several copies of each thru the years)...A clear proof of Peter Falk's stardom

Here's one of them, not a Columbo poster but one which clearly is designed to be reminiscent of the series' visuals, i.e. the Italian poster of the 1978 heist comedy, <u>The Brink's Job</u>.

Movie detectives are dime a dozen and Columbo is in the top hierarchy along with <u>Clint</u> <u>Eastwood</u> who portrayed Inspector 'Dirty' Harry Callahan in no less than 5 movies. This is the colorful Italian 1 Foglio poster for the third episode of the Series, <u>The Enforcer</u>.

Grit, violence and charisma define <u>Steve McQueen</u>'s in <u>The Getaway</u>, the 1972 violent thriller directed by <u>Sam Peckinpah</u>. Here is the hard to find large 2 panel Italian poster designed for the 1978 rerelease of the movie with unique artwork

Tough guys are not just the reserved domain of Hollywood. <u>Jean Gabin</u> and <u>Lino</u> <u>Ventura</u> display even more toughness in the classic 1955 French Noir movie, <u>Razzia sur</u> <u>la chnouf</u>, hereby represented by its colorful Belgian poster.

Even more colorful is the super rare 1967 day-glo inked head shop poster featuring Pop Art legend Peter Max with a self portrait.





More day-glo colors with another very rare poster. This one for the 1976 Portland concert of Country Rock duo <u>Seals And Croft</u>.

As those psychedelic colors make me trip, I invite you to go up to space with a brand new fabulous limited edition print by Michael De Pippo cleverly revisiting Looney tunes' beloved character <u>Marvin The Martian</u>.

We stay in space where no one can hear you but can still kiss! Beautiful and rare Japanese poster for the cult Anime Sci-Fi TV series, <u>Space Adventure Cobra</u>.



Romance is everywhere...lconic image for Blues mouth harp legend <u>Charlie</u> <u>Musselwhite</u>'s 1968 Torrance concert, inspired by the Romance comic books which were all the rage in the late 60's.

Everyone can love and be loved. It's in our DNA no matter how weird you are. Fantastic limited edition print by <u>Todd Slater</u> titled <u>Too Weird To Love Too Rare To Die</u>...inspired by *Living And Loathing In Las Vegas*.



Weird...Genial German designer <u>Gunther Kieser</u> definitely was. Just check the large poster for the <u>1999 Frankfurt Jazz Festival</u> to understand why he was both weird and a genius

Another genial weirdo was Director <u>Ken Russell</u> who filmed one of the strangest Musical ever, i.e. <u>Tommy</u>, adapted from <u>The Who</u>'s Rock Opera featuring the band';s golden god, Roger Daltrey. Rare large sized German poster.

One of the weirdest stage performers with a voice that was as unique as powerful was <u>Joe Cocker</u>. His <u>Mad Dogs And Englishmen</u> Tour is one of the best ever musical live show and the movie documentary perfectly captures its madness and rawness. Rare colorful Belgian poster.

John Travolta and Samuel Jackson certainly act as two mad dogs in <u>Pulp Fiction</u>, one of <u>Quentin Tarantino</u>'s many masterpieces here revisited by Dave Merrell on this great limited edition print.









Women know how to make men act as mad dogs too. Rare large 2 panel Italian poster for the 1979 Greek Sexploitation movie <u>Intimate Relations</u>. Check how very happy the man in the background is!!!

Sex can be happy or frankly weird as our Japanese friends love to display their shibari skills in so many <u>Pinky Bondage movies</u> such as the 1974 Retrospective of the genre, <u>Japan Pinky Film Comprehensive</u>.

Weird can also be Artistic as we can witness on this ultra rare concert poster titled <u>Blues</u> <u>Spectacular</u> designed for the 1973 Miami Blues Festival. Not many copies exist. A true rarity.

Weirdness, Horror and Sex go well together...At least on posters. Another great painting by <u>Mario Piovano</u> used on the Italian insert sized poster for the 1968 British movie <u>Behind Locked Doors</u>.

Sleeping can be restful or eerie as the iconic painting by <u>Renato Casaro</u> shows <u>Terence Hill</u> about to be awakened by fearsome shadows on the large 2 panel Italian poster for the 1976 Spaghetti Western, <u>A Genius Two Friends And A Dupe</u>













Legendary Franco-Belgian comic book icon, <u>Lucky Luke</u>, is another Cowboy but who is actually faster than his shadow. Rare poster for a 1998 German Museum retrospective of Goscinny and Morris' oeuvre.

Newly crowned King Charles was just received "en grande pompe" at the Chateau de Versailles by the French President. I hope the former will repay the latter's courtesy by inviting him soon to Buckingham Palace (still inexplicably vacant for 4 years now...Renovation???) and displaying British pomp as shown on this vintage <u>Great Britain travel poster</u> circa 1980.
