LINEN BACKING/RESTORATION SERVICES

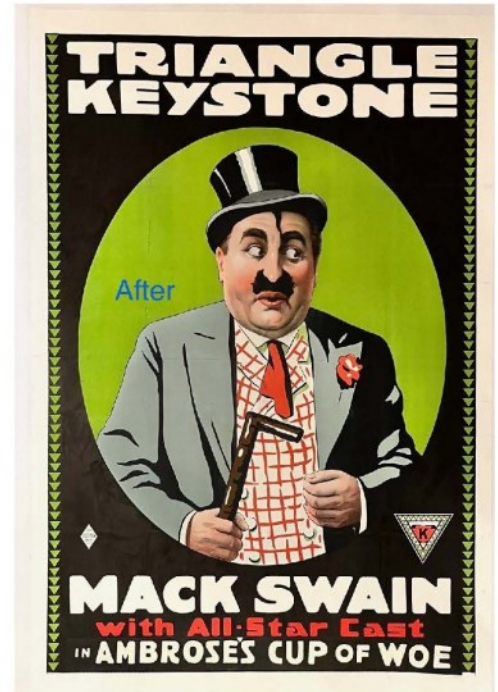
EXPERIENCE

I have been linen backing for over two years since retiring and have completed over 100 poster restorations for Morris Everett of The Last Moving Picture Company. It began when Morris gave me some old posters to practice on and learn the process. Once perfected, I was quickly able to make this passion of mine, a full-time venture. My previous skills as an Executive Manager have allowed me to constantly improve my linen backing business and expand.

PROCESS

In terms of linen backing, I use nothing but conservation techniques. What does that mean? It means I wash EVERY poster; firstly, to deacidify, this opens up the paper fibers to allow the paper bleach to remove stains, toning, water damage, etc. The poster is then mounted on acid free paper, and adhered to 12-ounce canvas. Once dry, the poster is then touched up with water color pencils. The process is fully reversible.

PERSONAL

For over 50 years, I have collected John Wayne memorabilia. My Grandparents took me to see "McClintock" when I was a just kid and so I wanted to learn more about John Wayne. That fascination turned into a very extensive collection. John Wayne made 170 movies and I have a poster or lobby card for about 140 of those movies. I also have art work and items Duke wore. Below are a few pictures from my collection. The patch is from Duke's jumpsuit.

Albert Kallis



Albert Kallis [1924-2024] was born in Kansas City, Missouri, in 1924. The son of Universal studio art director Maurice Kallis, Albert has his father's gift for art. He went to the Art Center College in Los Angeles. In 1948, Albert left to live in Paris for a year and upon his return he became a free-lance illustrator for Universal Pictures, Saul Bass and others.

In 1955, Roger Corman hired him to do a campaign for *Gunslinger* that was released by American Releasing Corporation that was soon to become American International Pictures. Albert made a handshake agreement to do all their advertising and posters. As their art director Albert conceived the campaigns, made the layouts for ads and posters and did the finished illustrations. When the workload became too

heavy, Kallis switched to management and concept design and used Reynold Brown and Joe Smith to help with the finishing.

During his 19 years with AIP, Kallis created campaigns from some of the movies scripts before they were made and with them Jim Nicholson started AIP's famous pre-production sell tactics. The theater distributors jumped on the film mainly because of the fantastic poster artwork.

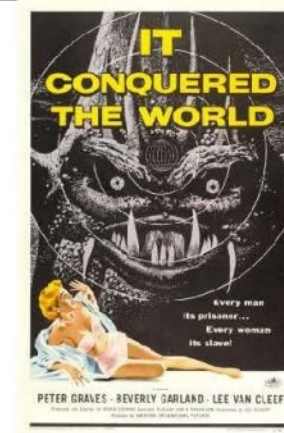
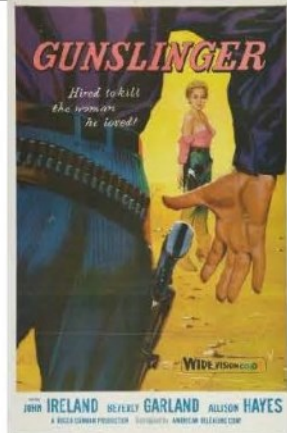
While working as art director for AIP, Albert became one of the founders of The International House of Pancakes now known as IHOP, an icon among America's most famous restaurant chains. He designed all of their original menus, ads and annual reports. In 1973, he left motion picture advertising to start a non-profit foundation with his wife Trudy. Together they have made award-winning documentaries for education, charities, and social causes. Their last, *Art Colonies in America - The American Impressionists* won the "Silver Screen Award" U.S. International Film and Video Festival 2005.

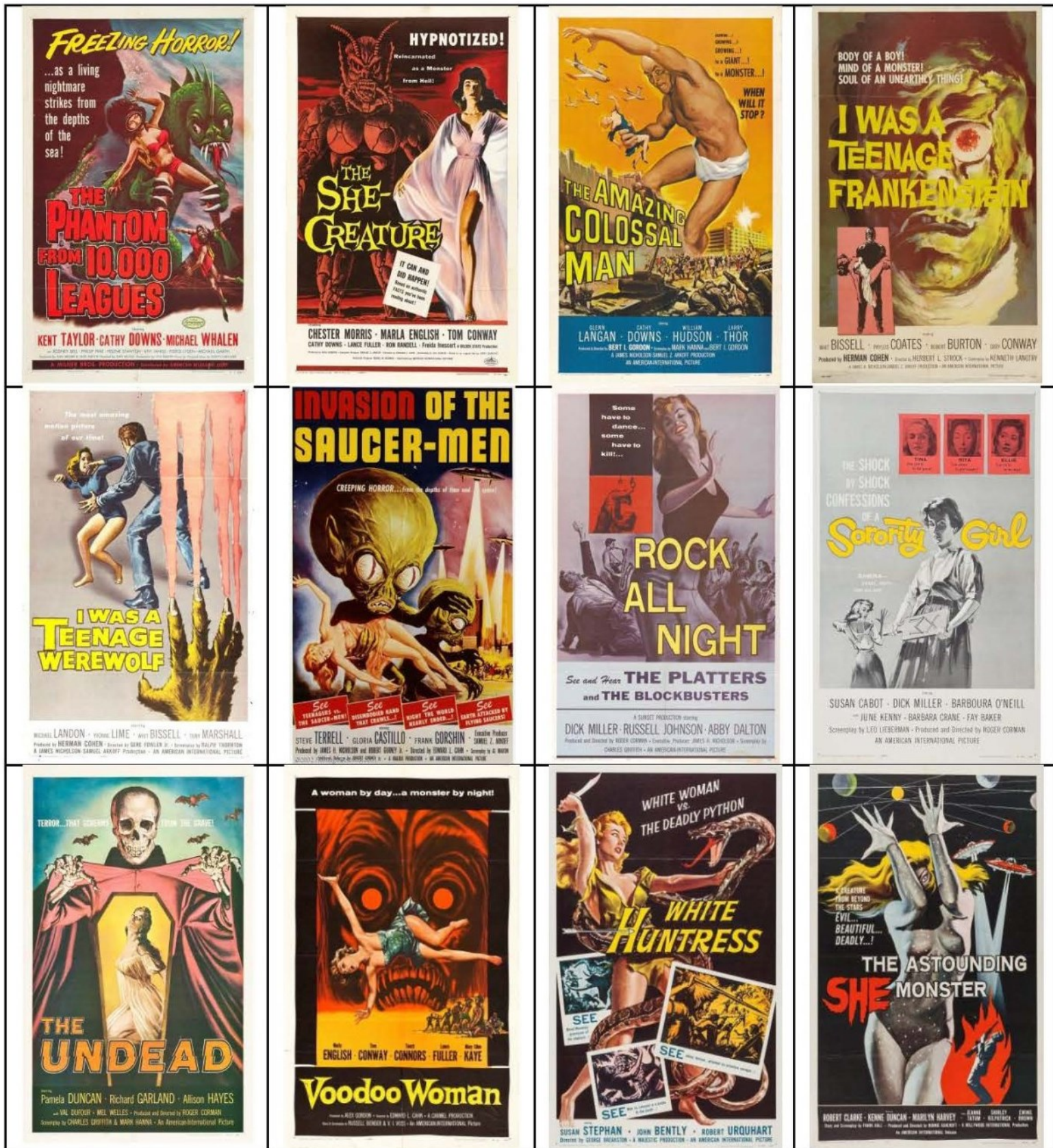

## R.I.P. Alain Delon (1935 – 2024)

The sacred monster of French cinema passed away. His magnetic presence made a dozen masterpieces vibrate, such as *IL GATTOPARDO* and *ROCCO E I SUOI FRATELLI* by Visconti or *LE SAMOURAI* by Jean-Pierre Melville. 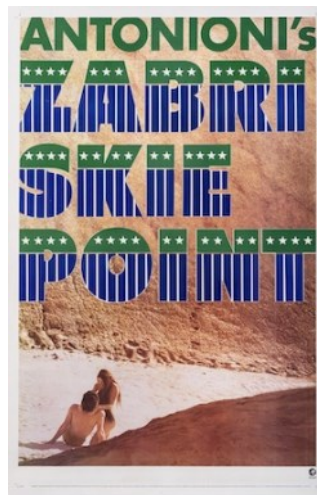
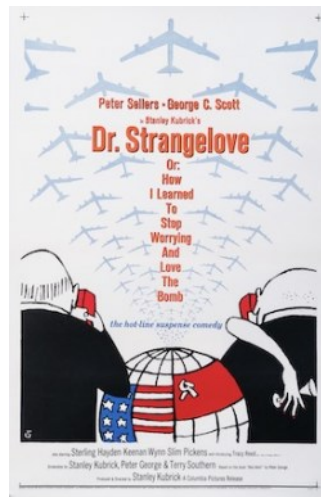
But there are no credits apart from the actors, and Terrence Malick's name seems to have been replaced by "Don Martin" (who may or may not be a pseudonym for Malick). At some point during the months that passed between the film's premiere at the 1973 NYFF (where it was picked up by Warners) and the final release date in March, WB seems to have lost faith in the film. According to producer Ed Pressman, he and Malick were "forced to book the film...in locations such as Little Rock, Arkansas, to demonstrate that the film could make money". So, my best guess is that this poster was produced for one of those test engagements (but if anyone knows otherwise, please let me know). In any case, it's a unique poster for one of the 1970's most acclaimed films.



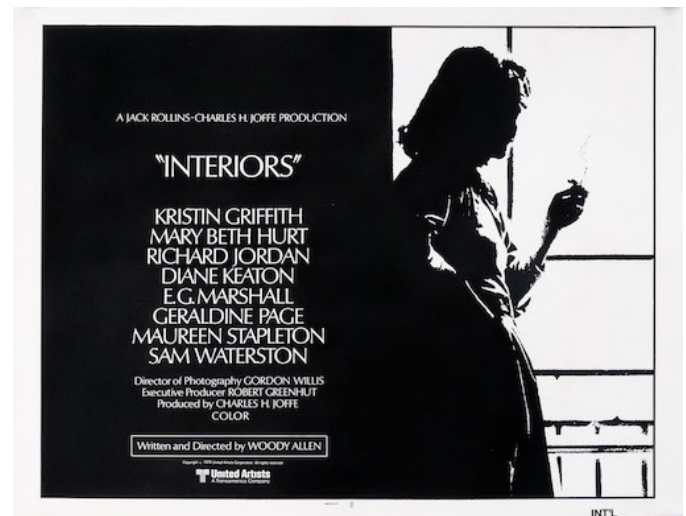
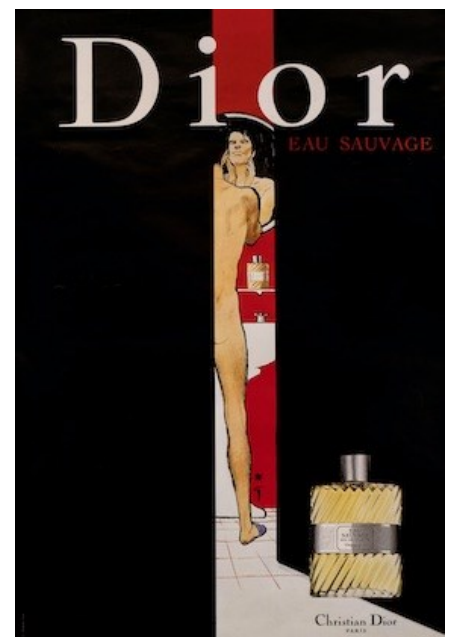
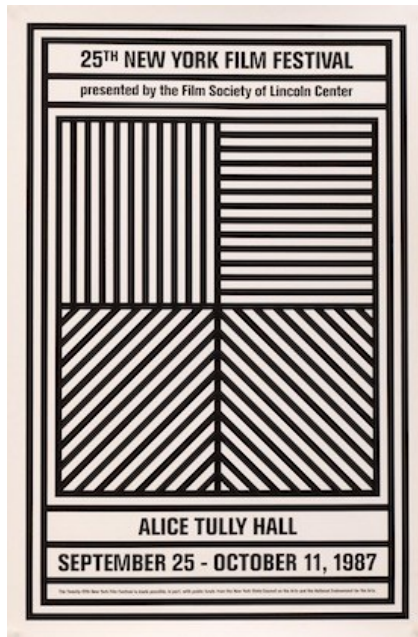
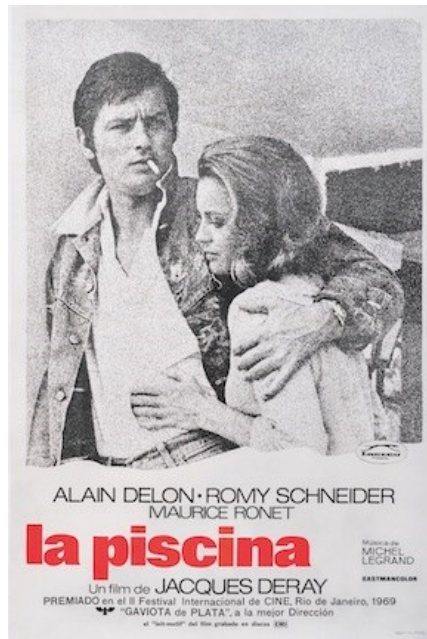

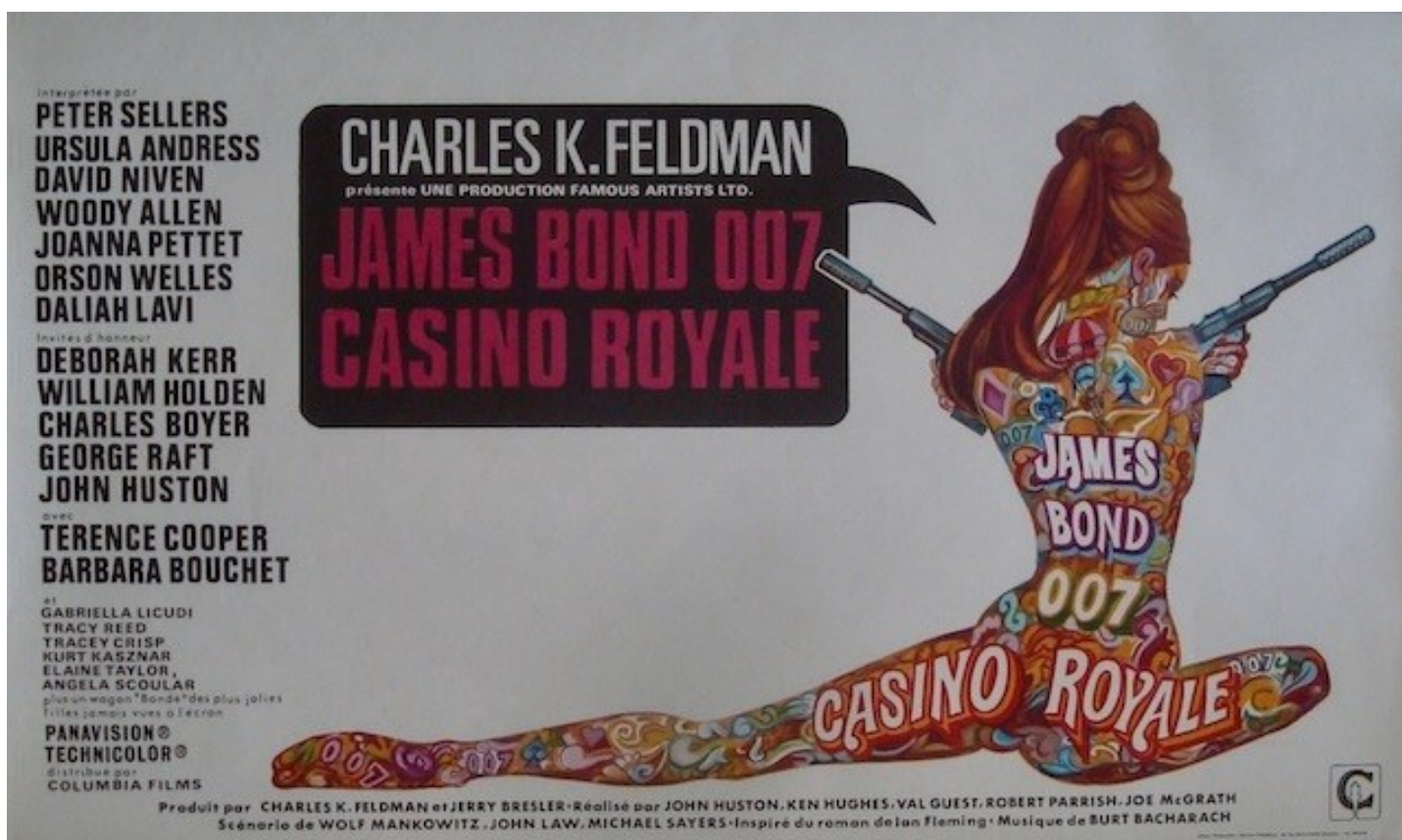

While not denying the sheer sex appeal of the Austrian and Swiss beauties above, let's not forget that Paris does have the most beautiful and elegant women, parading a regal quality whether the ages. [Simone Signoret](#) sure demonstrated this in the early 20th century era Parisian classic [Casque d'or](#), Very rare original French Moyenne poster.

More French beauties (male and female) with no less than [Alain Delon](#), [Mylene Demongeot](#), [Pascale Petit](#) and [Jacqueline Sassard](#) on the impossible to find original Japanese poster for the 1959 French comedy, [Faibles Femmes \(3 Murderesses\)](#).



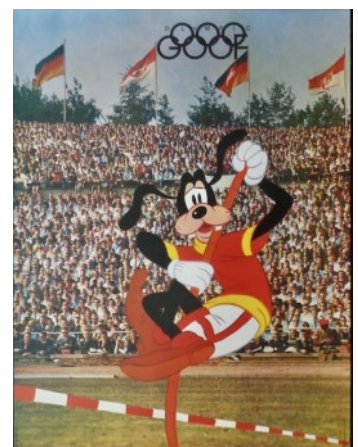


Tourists and Olympians praised the local hosts' warmth and jovial attitude throughout the games as the notoriously aloof Parisians showed they were no longer cranky and distant towards all who are not Parisians. It is also a relief to know that no tourist woman has been burned in a furnace as was the "practice" in the 1910's with the infamous *Landru* (*Bluebeard*) who was comically satirized by [Charles Chaplin](#) in [Monsieur Verdoux](#). Colorful Japanese poster printed for the 1974 rerelease.

While the Paris 2024 logo was quite clever (a bob headed female in the flame), the majority of the visuals were not on par with the magnificence of the locations and events. They should have hired true genial designers such as [Yusaku Kamekura](#) who created the visuals for the [Expo 70 in Osaka](#). Stunning poster titled Progress And Harmony For Humanity.

Probably the most brilliant Olympics designs ever were the ones created by [Otl Aicher](#) for the [1972 Munich Olympics](#). Aside from the posters for each competition, they were others (much rarer as non commercialized) designed for non Olympics events including this large poster for the exhibition Olympia und Technik. A Gallery exclusive.

The very ugly red revolutionary hat was the 'mascot' of the Paris Games. Let's hope Los Angeles will choose a more lovable character maybe Goofy as he was used on [this rare poster printed around the 1972 Munich Olympics](#).

[L.A. Confidential](#), the filmed adaptation of the classic James Ellroy novel. Original style B Japanese poster.



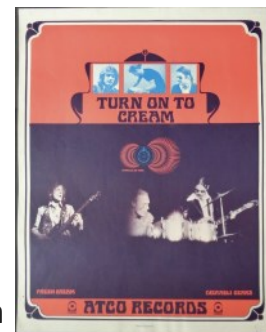

Facing the Trocadero, under the Eiffel Tower, le Champ de Mars will soon be stripped of its specially built arena to give back to all Parisian lovers one of the most beautiful perspectives of the city as can be appreciated on the vintage original (circa 1962) travel poster for [Trans Canada Airlines](#) advertising flights to Paris on the then brand new DC 8.

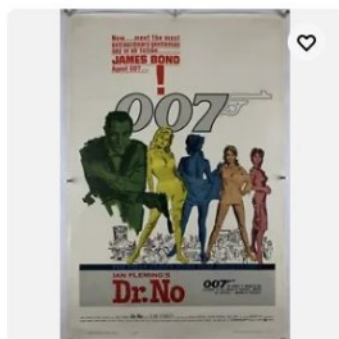
