

Given the sensational results of our <u>August Major Auction</u> (and also ALL our other auctions this past year) I can't see why **ANYONE** with quality items they have considered consigning would not want to have them included in this very special auction! And unlike every other major auction we **DON'T** have a big stack of supposedly sold items here to put back into auction, so we are "starting from scratch", just like always (the 7 items pictured here are among the very first December Major consignments received)!

I **KNOW** December sounds a very long way off, but it starts December 1st, which means the final deadline to consign is November 1st! And while that **IS** around 6 weeks off, there are two great advantages to consigning now rather than later. One is that you guarantee yours gets in (in the case of duplicated items) and the other is we may use your items in our early previews, which can help significantly raise the final selling price.

We have made one very important change to consigning. We have had the rule about \$30+ (in nice condition) or \$50+ (in lesser condition) for regular consignments for over a year now, and it is working out great, getting low value items out of our auctions. THE CHANGE IS THAT LINENBACKED ITEMS MUST BE SOLIDLY \$100+ (and the poster itself must sell for \$50+ unbacked).

Our last several major auctions have had 100 or 200 much lesser posters that were solely included because they were linenbacked, and we don't want this anymore **AT ALL**. So bear this in mind before sending consignments.

And know that what we DO want is really rare and desirable items, like the ones our <u>August Major Auction</u> was full of (see the below section for links to EVERY result)! If you have items you think make sense, contact us today with what you have, and you may see your items in our next preview ad!





eMoviePoster.com's e-mail club began in June of 1998, and there have been 1,042 club messages, and they are searchable online, and past messages are FILLED with valuable info found nowhere else on the Internet?

In May of 1990 I, Bruce Hershenson, became a full-time movie poster auctioneer, and that year I took in around two million dollars from my movie poster auctions and my semi-annual sales catalogs.

By early 1998 I was hearing more and more about something called "the World Wide Web" and I decided to join it and see if there was any way to use it to enhance my auction business! Over the next few months I began emailing with some of my customers, and in June of 1998 (WAY before I held my first online auction or sale of ANY kind) I decided to start a weekly email club, offering a great deal each week to the members, and also sharing news about the hobby, and info for newer collectors. I sent that first club message to 35 people, with an offer for the hardcover book Graven Images (which was published at \$50) for just \$10 for one copy of this wonderful book!

Here is that very first historic club message from June of 1998 (emailed to just 35 people!):

"This is the first of a series of e-mails I will be sending once a week to everyone in my e-mail club. The common denominator that joins everyone in this club is that we all collect vintage movie posters. The club can be anything you want it to be. My sole purpose in creating it is to make it easier for people to learn more about collecting. When I first started back in 1969, it was extremely difficult for new collectors to learn about the hobby. Now there are many ways to gain knowledge about many different aspects of poster collecting, and the internet will make it easier than ever to quickly learn about collecting, and how to avoid costly "mistakes". Please send me any suggestions you have along this line. I'm open to any idea. I am moving in August to a much larger warehouse which will allow me to pursue a lot of projects that I couldn't do for lack of space. I have tons of material (books and posters) and there's a lot of things that I'd rather sell than move. So you're going to see a lot of items offered in these weekly e-mails at ridiculously low prices. It will all be on a first come, first served basis. This week, I'm going to offer copies of Graven Images, the great hardcover book. It originally sold for \$50, and I bought out all of the remaining copies and I currently sell them for \$35 each. Unfortunately for me, just about every case contained one copy that has a two or three inch "slice" in the dustjacket, where somebody at the printing plant cut open the boxes with a blade, and cut just deeply enough to "score" the jacket (sometimes on the front, sometimes on the back). Otherwise the book and the jacket are just about perfect. I'll sell anyone in this club (while my supply lasts) these "sliced" copies for only ten dollars each! Because each book weighs three pounds, I'll need \$5 shipping for the first book, and \$1 each additional (in the United States; elsewhere you'll have to pay the actual shipping costs). To make things more exciting, I'll give the first five people who order one copy for free (if they order one, there's no charge, if they order two or more, they'll get one free). I'll go strictly by the order in which I receive your e-mail orders. To order, send me an e-mail, and be sure to include your shipping address and how you are going to pay. This offer expires June 14th or when my supply is exhausted. Next e-mail I'll give a lot of news updates, as well another special offering. If you don't want to get the next one, just email me, and I'll take you out of the club."

Over the years, the club has grown and grown, and this week we have **17,093** members (not bad from those humble beginnings)!

Please know that the search for the club works different from that of our Auction History and Galleries in that it searches the exact phrase you type. Because of this, you may perform a search and get a large number of results. If so, then you should think of a different word or phrase to search for. If you get too few results, you should reduce the length of the phrase you are using or try searching for different keywords. We will make the search "smarter" in the future.

Also note that all club messages prior to #325 were "condensed" in an effort to make it easier to access the unique information presented in each message and to eliminate the information about the current week's offerings. Messages #325 and on are presented as they were originally issued, so they will always refer to past auctions and/ or events that are no longer relevant, but they also contain unique information such as news and general movie paper info that is certainly still relevant. Also in those club messages prior to #325 we had some regular features in the club (like questions and answers and collector profiles) which we "stripped out' of those messages and put on a different part of our site.

One of the most valuable features of the early club messages were the many questions I published each week from club members. Back then, so **MANY** people were discovering movie poster collecting (and the hobby) each week through the Internet that I would receive lots of emails every week with questions about many different aspects of posters and poster collecting.

Each week I would spend around 3 hours compiling all the questions that had been asked that week, and I would write out answers to each and every one of them, and publish them in the club messages.

So if YOU want to learn a LOT more about posters and poster collecting, I advise you to look at the old club messages (either one by one, or by searching them) and I think you will be amazed at how much good information is contained

And if you find any incorrect or outdated information, let me know what that is so I can correct it!

And of course, starting January 5, 2020, this formerly weekly email club become a bi-weekly email club, because on January 7th, 2020 our auctions became bi-weekly auctions! And starting July 4, 2021, this club became a monthly email club, because on July 6, 2021 our auctions became "every four week" auctions!

For the autumn appointment with cinema, Aste Bolaffi beats all records with a very rich and dense catalogue with no less than 730 lots spanning the entire 20th Century.

The auction opens with a rich selection of sought-after posters with an international flavour of silent movies and concludes with a timeless masterpiece: the first edition poster for 'The Battleship Potemkin', illustrated by master Rodchenko. A much sought-after and now practically unobtainable poster, of which only one other example is known to have passed through auctions in Turin at Aste Bolaffi several years ago.





This is followed by a rich selection of material dedicated to Italian, European and finally American cinema, and at the end of the catalogue an amusing section of lots that start with very advantageous offers: these are posters made for Italian B-Movies, but also for minor subjects and very recent titles that might, however, appeal to younger collectors.

















IN MEMORIAM

The movie poster community suffered two great losses with the recent passing of these two gentlemen.



RUDY FRANCHI

Rudy was a dealer in movie memorabilia, graphic design ephemera, animation art advertising, war, travel, exhibition. film posters and rock posters since 1969. He, along with his wife Barbara, owned The Nostalgia Factory (Montreal, Newport, R. I.and Boston, MA, 1969 to 2005) and the website nostalgia.com. He was the author of Miller's Movie Collectibles (Phaidon Press, 2000) and has conducted major cataloged auctions of vintage movie posters at Skinner of Boston, Heritage of Dallas and Christie's New York.

For the first 17 years, Rudy was an on air appraiser for the PBS series Antiques Roadshow where he conducted over 100 on air appraisals of a wide range of collectibles,

including posters and other design oriented ephemera. He done appraisal work for such institutions as the Boston Public Library (Print Department); the University Of North Carolina Poster Collection; The Margaret Herrick Library of the Academy Of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences; the Library of Congress 20th Century Poster Collection; The Ridley Scott poster collection; The Marc Benda Collection of Modern Posters(donated to the Cooper Hewitt design branch of the Smithsonian Institutions, NY) and the design/poster department of the Los Angeles County Museum of Art.

Rudy was a true pioneer in our industry, and he was a great friend. He will be missed.

DWAYNE PINKNEY

For more than twenty-five years, Dwayne worked as Morris Everett's general manager at The Last Moving Picture Company in Ohio. LMPC holds one of the largest collections of movie posters, stills and memorabilia in the world, and Dwayne proved to be a knowledgeable and enthusiastic right-hand man to Morrie.

In addition to his work at LMPC, Dwayne was also a freelance artist and journalist whose paintings and articles were featured in several publications including Shadowland Magazine, Modern Focus, and Big Reel. He was also an award-winning model kit builder and



painter. His love of monsters and old movies began with the Aurora Monster model kits he got as a young boy. Dwayne loved to share his fondness for the hobby and his techniques with other enthusiasts and ran a large Facebook group with over 11,000 followers.

As Fall is about to start tomorrow, I thought it would be a good time to momentarily put the Blog to rest and to just highlight some of the still available posters from the **SUMMER POSTER COLLECTION**.

It seems that Lebanon is experiencing some massive communication problems with mysteriously exploding devices. Let's not forget that this country was up till the early 1970's a haven of peace dubbed the Switzerland Of Middle East. Let's hope it will soon become one again despite the dark clouds hovering over the region. Original <u>1969 Japan</u> <u>Airlines poster advertising flights to Beirut</u>. The Poster is already linen backed.

Afraid of picking up the phone? Don't be as a nice surprise may await you at the end of the line! Large French poster for the 1975 French erotic movie <u>Les goulues</u> (also known as *Sexy Peppers*). Pink pasties are added to

avoid the various platforms' censorship (where hate speech is allowed but not nipples!)

Guns are constantly in the news whether AR-15 or even more so handguns, the latter being sadly the source of the most deaths in the US. Yet the weapon of choice of most thrillers is the pump rifle as used by <u>Steve McQueen</u> in <u>The Getaway</u> and thought by the Japanese distributor to be a good way to promote the movie!?!

<u>Bruce Springsteen</u> just concluded his epic tour with another marathon show in his New Jersey hometown. 45 years ago in 1979, he - and a bunch of other musical luminaries (James Taylor, CSN, Tom Petty, The Doobie Brothers...) - played 2 shows in New York's famed Madison Square Garden against nuclear proliferation. The shows were later called <u>No Nukes</u> after the documentary movie but the original MUSE concert poster shown here is extremely hard to find.



If The Beatles were the biggest band in the world in the 1960's, they were massively outsold in Japan by the instrumental group the Ventures up till 1966 (when The Fab Four finally visited the country). The Ventures' 1965 Japanese tour was filmed and released as a concert documentary called <u>Beloved Invaders The Ventures</u> whose Japanese poster is extremely rare.

Mid 60's Japan was a beacon of cool with great style and Art as shown on the great poster of the 1964 Yakuza movie, <u>Call My Black Dice</u> starring <u>Akira Kobayashi</u>

Weird Art German style Part 1 with one of the most iconic Rock images thanks to <u>Gunther</u> <u>Kieser</u> who designed this poster dubbed *Medusa* for <u>Jimi Hendrix's 1969 German Tour</u>. The original poster and image were an instant hit prompting Darien House, the US based Gallery, to license it and print commercial posters for the international market. It is easy to recognize the difference between the original German posters and the Darien House ones as the Stuttgart concert date printed never actually happened on that date. Several fakes and subsequent limited edition prints were printed but never in the same size as this original poster.

Weird Art German style Part 2 with a truly deranged collage by <u>Grindler</u> for the 1971 German theatrical adaptation of Gregor Bals' book, <u>Montefosco oder der feudalherr</u>. One of the many German theater posters added in the Collection.









Deranged Art and deranged films with the US one sheet poster for the release of <u>Women In Cell Block 7</u>, the1973 Italian Exploitation movie. One of the many <u>Women In Prison movie posters</u> we offer.

Thankfully some good souls are saving those damsels in distress...such as <u>James Stewart</u> in the classic Western, <u>Broken Arrow</u>. Beautiful and colorful Italian Poster painted by <u>Rodolfo Gasparri</u> for the 1964 rerelease.

<u>Superman</u> is not only saving people from outside dangers but was also enlisted in a late 1970's anti smoking Health campaign in the UK to scan lungs thanks to his X-Ray vision powers. <u>Rare advertising British</u> <u>Public Service poster</u>.

Breast diseases are also numerous so that may be the reason why they appear on so many movie posters!!!! Insert sized poster for <u>Hard Sensation</u>, the 1980 Italian erotic movie.

One of <u>Jean-Paul Belmondo</u>'s few box office flops in the 1960's is <u>Le voleur (Thief Of Paris)</u>, the much underrated 1967 drama directed by <u>Louis Malle</u> which I urge you to track and watch. Very rare style B large Grande poster.

The Paris Olympics' aura is clearly gone with the now usual demonstrations and strikes lurking again in the city of lights. Let's then focus on another amazing Olympics, i.e. the <u>1968 Mexico</u> Olympics Games represented here by the German poster and its great design.

The 1960's were indeed the decade of creative design as shown again with this very rare 1966 concert poster for <u>Southbound Freeway</u> at Detroit's Grande Ballroom. Art by the genial <u>Gary</u> <u>Grimshaw</u>

The 1960's were also the decade of Kitsch, topped by the rubber creatures used in so many Japanese *Kaiju* movies such as <u>Frankenstein Conquers The World</u>. Great image used for the 1972 rerelease of <u>Ishiro Honda</u>'s classic.





If you are not afraid of fire breathing rubber monsters, you should however be cautious when meeting a Mako shark (the fastest of the species) underwater. Large 2 panel Italian poster for <u>Mako The Jaws Of Death</u>.




From one realm of silence to another (space) with the superb painting by <u>Noriyoshi Ohrai</u> for <u>The</u> <u>Empire Strikes Back</u>, the second Star Wars movie (Episode V). This is the rare Japanese poster version for the movie soundtrack.

Back to the 60's with a truly odd large sized concert poster designed for the <u>Steve Miller Band</u>'s 1969 Fort Worth show - although no such show appears in any concert database. Not only the design is striking but the poster is flocked (a technique adding velvety texture to enhance the glow in dark black light effects!

(American) Football season has started again. While I really don't get the game, I always loved the outfits and helmets of those athletes. Back in the late 60's <u>United Airlines</u> launched a (now extremely hard to find) series of posters focusing on each main sport (Baseball, Hockey, basketball...) featuring the logos of each major team. This is the one for the NFL teams. The poster is already linen backed
