How do you know if you are getting one of these posters? Well, here's something the crooks didn't know about.

All of the above posters were graded AND MARKED by [MP Grading](#). OK, what does that mean?

That means that each have an identifiable invisible ink DNA stamp. If you wave a UV light over the bottom of the poster, you will see an identification number.

The police are happy because NOW they have a way to identify the owner of THAT specific poster AND gives a greater chance in tracking down the thief.

The insurance company is happy because they are more likely to reclaim their insurance money and prosecute the crook once the police has caught him.



KERRY HAGGARD ENTERS A GUILTY PLEA

On October 24, 2011, Kerry Haggard pled guilty to the one count of mail fraud charged against him in April of 2010. This according to the court records of the United States District Court of the Southern District of New York.

The original complaint filed against Haggard alleged that the defendant traded and sold fake horror movie posters and lobby cards which he falsely represented as authentic, thereby defrauding dozens of victims and causing over a million dollars worth of loss.

Sentencing is currently set for January 24, 2012.
