


WE'RE BACK ... FROM THE COLUMBUS MOVING PICTURE SHOW

As we move toward LAMP's 25th anniversary online, we are updating and moving many of the main articles to videos to make it more convenient.

We will be adding new videos each month as we update and streamline the LAMP website. Each video is designed to provide more in-depth information aimed at helping all levels from beginners up through institution archivists.

The videos are presented in 3 major categories:

- Foundation for basic principles to allow all collectors, dealers and institutions to finally have the same basic information on how different areas work.

 video covers the status of movie posters from a preservation standpoint and the
 importance of movie poster collecting and what collectors need to know about
 preservation.
- 7. **Learn About 21 Types of U.S. One Sheets** This article video shows 21 different variations of the U.S. one sheet posters that anyone interested in movie posters should know about. Two additional types: Ghost posters and Alternative posters are not covered because they both fall more under the category of Limited Editions.





We were consigned a truly awe-inspiring collection of great James Bond posters, including these two incredibly rare TWENTY FOUR SHEETS! We have included an image of Connery from each of these next to each poster, so you can get a good sense of just how huge these billboard posters are in person!

And this collection also includes 6-sheets, 3-sheets, subway posters, one-sheets, half-sheets and more.

If **YOU** have rare James Bond material you would consider consigning, you could do no better than to send it in the next 7 days (but check with us first to make sure we don't already have what you have).











One of the most important things every major collector NEEDS to do is leave word with their relatives or heirs about what to do with their collection after they are gone!

Very sadly many collectors don't want to face their own mortality, and, after they pass away, their heirs often have **NO IDEA** what to do with the collections they often spent several decades building? Over the years, I, Bruce Hershenson, have received a lot of phones from the relatives or heirs of a collector who recently passed away, and they tell me that the collector told them, "If anything ever happens to me, call Bruce Hershenson at this number, because he will be completely honest with you **AND** you will get the most possible money".

But I have also received a surprising number of phone calls where the relatives or heirs of the collector who recently passed away left them no instructions, but they went through their papers and found a number of invoices from me, so they figured they would start by calling me. Almost always those relatives or heirs end up consigning to us, so they were not hurt by the collector not informing them.

But in many other cases, the relatives or heirs have no clue what to do, and in the worst case, they sometimes sell the collection to a dealer for pennies on the dollar (and often those collectors will brag about what a "great deal" they got). But also unfortunate is when the relatives or heirs choose an auction that is nearby to where they live, or they go on Google and call the auction that takes out the biggest ads (not realizing that the reason they can afford those big ads is because they charge the highest fees).

This sadly happened with two recent auctions of collections from a single owner. One was a collection of all horror/sci-fi items, and the other was a collection of mostly classic Warner Bros one-sheets. Both auctions had overall lackluster results, and in both cases I feel 100% sure we at eMoviePoster.com would have received substantially overall higher results.

But that is not all. Because of the **FAR** higher overall commissions those auctions charge, in both cases the consignors received **FAR** less from the auctions they gave the collections to than they would have received from us, likely maybe half as much overall. So if you don't want this to happen to your relatives or heirs, make 100% sure they know who to contact in case something happens to you, and make sure they have the contact info!

TWENTY FIVE MONTHS AGO I MADE A COMMITMENT TO ALL OF YOU! It is now the middle of June 2025. I will continue running this business (just as I have for the past 35 years) through the end of 2026, at the very least! But I DO reserve the right to raise our minimum for consignments even more during that time (likely to \$100 in nice condition).

After 12/31/26, I make no promises at this time. I MAY WELL continue longer (especially as I am SO liking the "new" eMoviePoster.com), or I MAY somewhat withdraw from the business so the employees run it more and more, or I MAY look for a buyer for it (possibly some of the employees themselves), or I MAY close it down!

SO WHAT DOES THIS MEAN FOR OUR CONSIGNORS? If YOU are someone with a house (or a warehouse) full of items, realize that for the next 19 months guaranteed you have a effortless way to sell all your items, both with no work on your part, and you get to deal with the most honest and most trusted auction there is!

AFTER 2026 comes to an end, do those of you with a house (or a warehouse) full of items have a "Plan B" if we are no longer auctioning (which may or may not happen)? You surely **DON'T** want to sell your items one at a time, and you surely know most dealers would offer you pennies on the the dollar, and you surely know that almost every other auction would charge you huge fees and only want your best stuff, so **SHOULDN'T YOU CONSIDER THE MERITS OF CONSIGNING TO US OVER THE NEXT NINETEEN MONTHS?**

And **PLEASE** don't tell me that your plan is to let your heirs worry about how to deal with your stuff after you are gone. That often works out terribly, and sometimes whole collections are literally trashed. Unless you positively hate your heirs, do not choose

Over and over the past few years, very long time collectors with huge collections have told this option! That time has now come, and all of you have 19 months left in which to figure out what to do, and you want to start thinking about this sooner than later!

Now I have no crystal ball! Maybe a new auction like ours will emerge down the line that offers a reasonable alternative to auctioning through us. I hope that occurs. But for right now, I feel that what I say above makes a massive amount of sense for those of you who are in an age bracket (or a point in your life or collecting) where you want and need to do **SOMETHING** with your collection sooner than later!

If YOU are someone like the collectors or dealers I describe above with a house (or a warehouse) full of items that you would love to no longer have (while getting them into the hands of people who will treasure, and with doing little work on your own), please feel free to email or phone me so we can discuss "your next step"!

Alfred Hitchcock - The Master of Suspense

For our current Alfred Hitchcock showcase, we are delighted to offer a superb one owner collection of nearly 100 original cinema posters from his films. Some of these are very rare, some are very valuable but they're all a fascinating part of the Hitchcock legacy.

Sir Alfred Joseph Hitchcock KBE was a British film director and producer, often referred to as "The Master of Suspense" due to his mastery of the suspense thriller genre.

In a career spanning six decades he directed over fifty feature films starting in the British film industry in the 1920s as a title designer before progressing to



become a director. He directed 23 films during the first phase of his career in England, including Blackmail (1929), one of the early British sound films. By the late 1930s, his profile was rising internationally, and he moved to Hollywood in 1939 before embarking on the most successful phase of his career, directing films including Psycho, The Birds, North By Northwest, Rear Window, Vertigo and To Catch a Thief. There were many more and he left behind an extraordinary legacy that few other directors can even approach.

Hitchcock is seen today as a director who managed to combine art and entertainment in a way very few have ever matched. His innovations and vision have influenced a great number of filmmakers, producers and actors. He remains by far the most-studied film director of all time.



After the spring success of Thunderbolts: The New Avengers, The Fantastic Four (5th cinematic attempt at making it right for Marvel's First Family!) - From Marvel Studios / Disney - and Superman (Warner Brothers) are the two blockbusters that aim at making the 2025 Summer be once again the Superhero Summer.

2025 will also mark the first time that ALL the Marvel Comics heroes are now under one brand and one studio (Disney) after having been scattered through different studios / ownerships over the last 23 years with X-Men and the FF at Fox Studios and Spider-Man at Columbia Pictures.

Warner Bros is also betting big on revamping the DC Universe (DCU) with the new iteration of Superman under James Gunn's creative direction.

However Superhero movies are nothing new on the screen as the massive commercial success of Superman, Batman and Captain America in the early 1940's (over 1 million copies of these marquee comics titles were printed on average each month during those Golden Age years) led to the production of TV Serials which were also screened in theaters.

The Superhero craze waned from the late 1940's till the Batman TV series in 1966 shook the medium creating a whole new generation of fans who started to buy everything related to cape costumed heroes. The success of the TV series spawned one of the campiest movies ever, i.e. Batman The Movie.

Marvel lagged behind DC in terms of bringing their franchise heroes to the screens (small or large) until 1977 when both The Incredible Hulk (starring Bill Bixby and Lou Ferrigno) and Spider-Man (starring Nicholas Hammond) appeared on TV screens in the US with instant massive local and international success.

The Incredible Hulk lasted 4 seasons (1977-1982) with several episodes edited for international theatrical releases while Spider-Man lasted 2 seasons and spawned 2 TV movies also released theatrically internationally.

This success was once again short-lived as the studios failed to understand the huge fan market that DC and Marvel had created with legions of loyal fans all around the world as well as being incapable of translating those stories into real Art

Many movies and TV movies were produced which should be forgotten (Fantastic Four by Roger Corman, Thor, Dr. Strange ...) to name a few of these visual atrocities.

Leave it once again to Batman to save the day with Tim Burton and Warner Bros relaunching the franchise in 1989 giving instant credibility to the Superhero genre and upending the Comic book market with a new generation of fans and investors understanding the sheer value of this untapped goldmine.

Since then and before the relaunch of Captain America, Iron Man and the Avengers in the early 2000s, there were many other successful and unsuccessful attempts at adapting marquee names (Spider-Man trilogy by Sam Raimi) and lesser known heroes (Blade, Doc Savage, Howard The Duck, The Rocketeer, The Shadow, The Punisher...)

I am asked all the time what does it mean to linen back using conservation techniques. There are two main elements in conservation techniques, first you must clean and deacidfy the paper to stop any further destruction of the paper. This process requires submerging the poster in water to remove dirt and acids embedded in the paper fibers. If you do not wash the poster properly, you are not removing the contamination.

The second most important step is in the restoration process by using water color pencils, and acid free wheat paste, and paper. This makes the process fully reversible.

The below is an example of a poster restored using conservation techniques by The Poster Doc team. The paper has been removed of all contaminates, and bringing back the colors to there vivid state.







EXPERIENCE

I have been linen backing for over two years, after I retired. I have completed over 100 poster restorations for Morris Everett. I started this business with the help of Morris. He gave me posters to learn the process; and once perfected, I gained his confidence to back his poster collection. I was an executive manager because of my constant process improvement skills and transferred those skills in my linen backing business.

PROCESS

With regards to linen backing. I linen back using conservation techniques. What does that mean? It means I wash EVERY poster, first step is to deacidfy, this opens up the paper fibers to allow the paper bleach to remove stains, toning, water damage, etc. The poster is then mounted on acid free Japanese paper, and 12oz. Canvas. Once dry the poster is then touched up with water color pencils. The process is fully reversible.

PRICING

I have set up my pricing so that almost any poster can be linen backed. My pricing includes a full bath (photo on right shows water after a poster bath) and deacidification of the poster. It includes a light bleaching to remove the mold, and toning to bring back the colors and the whiteness of the paper, then a PH balance bath to neatralize the paper. The poster is then mounted on acid free Japanese Masa paper and mounted on 12 oz. cotton backing. The price also includes minor tape removal, and water color touch ups along the fold lines.
